INTERIM DEAN, SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH, CHICAGO

Action: Approve Interim Dean, School of Public Health, Chicago

Funding: State Appropriated Funds

The Chancellor at Chicago has recommended the appointment of Sylvia E. Furner, currently Associate Professor of Epidemiology, Division of Epidemiology and Biostatistics, and Senior Associate Dean, School of Public Health, and NCAA Liaison, Office of the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management, as Interim Dean, School of Public Health, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, on 100 percent time, at an annual salary of \$121,000 (equivalent to an annual nine-month base salary of \$99,000 plus two-ninths annualization of \$22,000) and an administrative increment of \$49,000, for a total annual salary of \$170,000, beginning July 1, 2006.

Dr. Furner will continue to hold the rank of Associate Professor of Epidemiology, Division of Epidemiology and Biostatistics, on indefinite tenure on an academic year service basis on zero percent time.

Dr. Furner will replace Susan C. Scrimshaw, who has accepted the position as President of Simmons College, Boston, Massachusetts.

This recommendation is made with the advice of the faculty and the Executive Committee of the College.

The board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes, The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs.
