RENAME THE AGRICULTURAL LEADERSHIP AND SCIENCE EDUCATION
PROGRAM, COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURAL, CONSUMER AND
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES, URBANA

Action: Rename the Agricultural Leadership and Science Education Program,
College of Agricultural, Consumer and Environmental Sciences

Funding: No New Funding Required

The Vice President, University of Illinois and Chancellor, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign with the advice of the Urbana-Champaign Senate recommends approval of a proposal from the College of Agricultural, Consumer and Environmental Sciences to rename the Agricultural Leadership and Science Education Program as the Agricultural Education Program.

On January 20, 2011, the Board of Trustees established the Agricultural Leadership and Science Education Program. However, upon review of the actions of the Urbana Senate, it was determined that the wrong name was presented to the Senate for consideration. On October 3, 2011, the Urbana Senate reaffirmed approval of the program with the appropriate name--Agricultural Education.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes, The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs with this recommendation. The University Senates Conference has indicated that no further Senate jurisdiction is involved.

The President of the University recommends approval. This action is subject to further review and approval by the Illinois Board of Higher Education.
