The Chancellor at Chicago recommends the appointment of John R. Loya, currently Associate Vice President for Human Resources and Associate Vice Chancellor for Health Affairs, as Vice Chancellor for Human Resources, Chicago, on a twelvemonth service basis, at the same annual salary of \$237,000, beginning February 1, 2006.
