## APPOINT ACTING DEAN, COLLEGE OF PHARMACY, CHICAGO

**Action:** Appoint Acting Dean, College of Pharmacy

**Funding:** State Appropriated Funds

The Vice President, University of Illinois and Chancellor of Chicago campus has recommended the appointment of Steven M. Swanson, currently Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Education, College of Pharmacy; Professor of Pharmacognosy, Department of Medicinal Chemistry and Pharmacognosy; and Professor of Surgical Oncology, College of Medicine at Chicago, as Acting Dean of the College of Pharmacy, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, on 100 percent time, at an annual salary of \$166,833 (equivalent to an annual nine-month base salary of \$136,500 plus two-ninths annualization of \$30,333), and an administrative increment of \$33,167, beginning January 24, 2011, for a total annual salary of \$200,000.

Dr. Swanson will continue to hold the rank of Professor of Pharmacognosy, in the Department of Medicinal Chemistry and Pharmacognosy, College of Pharmacy, on indefinite tenure, on an academic year service basis, on zero percent time, non-salaried, effective January 3, 2011; Professor of Surgical Oncology, College of Medicine at Chicago, non-tenured, on an academic year service basis, on zero percent time, non-salaried, effective August 16, 2010; and Associate Dean for Research and Graduate

Education, on an academic year service basis, on zero percent time, non-salaried, effective January 3, 2011. He was appointed as Acting Dean Designate under the same conditions and salary arrangement effective January 3, 2011.

Dr. Swanson succeeds Dean Jerry L. Bauman who was appointed to serve as Interim Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Provost Designate, effective January 3, 2011, and who has delegated the duties of the Dean to Dr. Swanson.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material aspects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes, the General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure,* and the Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs with this recommendation.

The President of the University recommends approval.
