# Overview of Online Education at UIS

- First UIS online degree program launched in 1997
- UIS now offers 12 online undergraduate degree programs, 11 online graduate degree programs; 8 online professional certification programs; and 13 online graduate certificate programs
- Partners with over 20 community colleges in Illinois
- Created unique partnership with California community college to deliver innovative 1+2+1 program for baccalaureate degree completion
- Has nearly 1,500 UIS online majors located in 47 states, Puerto Rico and 3 Canadian provinces; 70 counties in Illinois; and 7 foreign countries
- Provides on-campus students scheduling flexibility through high quality on campus and online course options taught by same faculty
- 97% of all 2015 UIS graduates took at least one online course toward degree completion

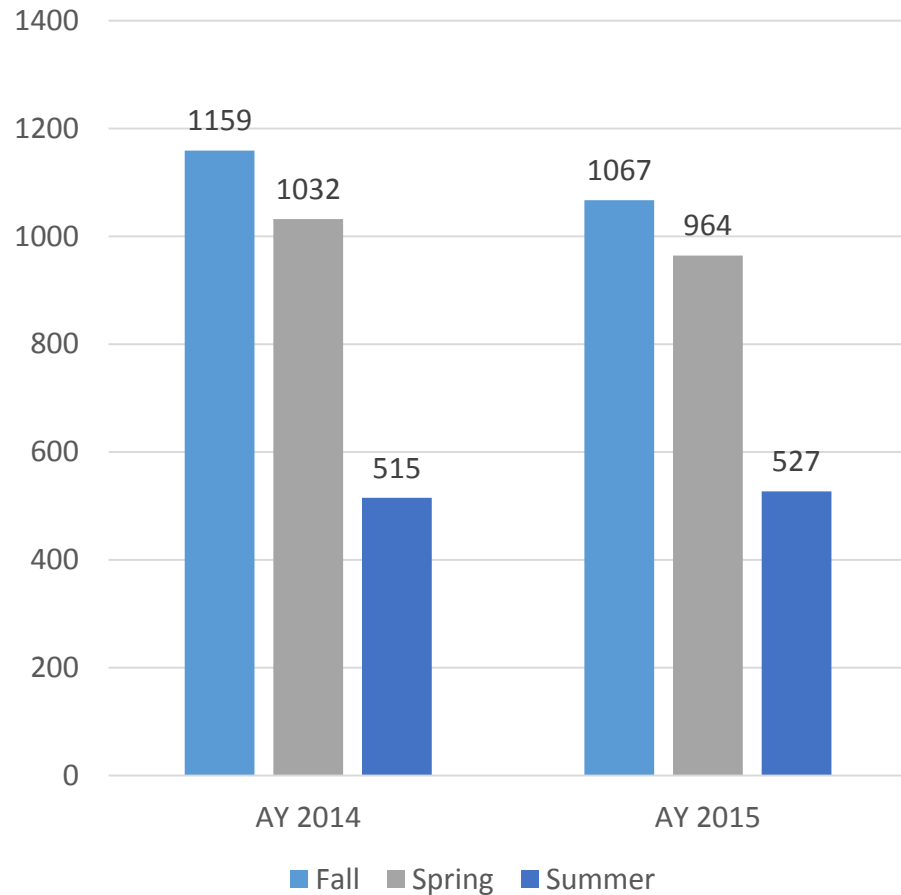

# Online Program Highlights

- **Ranked #2 by U.S. News and World Report for Best Online Bachelor's Programs and #1 for Student Engagement in 2015**
  - **Bachelor of Science in Health Information Management (AHS)**
  - **RN-BSN Online Degree Completion (CON)**
- **RN-BSN Online Program Partnerships**
  - **10 community colleges**
  - **3 hospitals**
- **Ranked #29 by U.S. News and World Report for Best Online Graduate Engineering Program in 2015**
- **UIC's MS in Patient Safety Leadership (PSL) was the first degree of its kind to be offered in the country online and inter-professionally**
- **Develop research emphasis in courses**
  - **e.g., over the past year, seven of the MS in PSL alums have presented or spoken at national conferences**
- **Students coming from 43 states and 9 foreign countries.**
  - **expand and attract non-traditional working adult students**

# Fully online courses and programs

- Total enrollments 21,551 (2010) → 37,581 (2015) 65% increase
- Number of degree programs (75), number of courses (496)
- Revenue: \$10.6m in 2013, \$24.2m in 2015
- Participation in G-9 national summit on online programs (one of only two public universities)



# MOOCs

- 35 MOOCs offered through Coursera
- 56 more in development (will make us the #1 MOOC provider in Coursera)
- Current enrollments: 2.6 million
- Revenue \$1.4 million, with new specializations (iMBA and others) coming online
- iMBA a unique national leader



# Serving on-campus students

- Reducing time to completion. Four year graduation rate: with no online courses (55-60%); taking at least one online course (70-75%)
- Winter session: first time offered (Winter 2014) course filled in minutes; now offering 17 Winter session courses
- Summer session: in 2010, 1825 credit hours transferred from non-UI courses; after LAS Online (2014) 1128 credit hours transferred – recapturing lost course registration and revenue
