RENAME THE MASTER OF SCIENCE AND DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN HUMAN AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURAL, CONSUMER AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES, AND THE GRADUATE COLLEGE, URBANA

- Action: Rename the Master of Science and Doctor of Philosophy in Human and Community Development, College of Agricultural, Consumer and Environmental Sciences, and the Graduate College
- **Funding:** No New Funding Required

The Chancellor, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and Vice

President, University of Illinois with the advice of the Urbana-Champaign Senate recommends approval of a proposal from the College of Agricultural, Consumer and Environmental Sciences and the Graduate College to rename of the Master of Science and Doctor of Philosophy in Human and Community Development as the Master of Science and Doctor of Philosophy in Human Development and Family Studies.

The Department of Human and Community Development has a companion proposal to change the name of their department from Human and Community Development to Human Development and Family Studies. This proposal aligns the graduate major name with the new department name, allowing for clarity of identity.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes*, *The*

General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs with this recommendation. The University Senates Conference has indicated that no further Senate jurisdiction is involved.

The President of the University recommends approval. This action is subject to further review and approval by the Illinois Board of Higher Education.
