APPOINT VICE CHANCELLOR FOR DIVERSITY, EQUITY AND INCLUSION, URBANA

Action: Appoint Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

Funding: State Appropriated Funds

The Chancellor, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and Vice President, University of Illinois recommends the appointment of Sean C. Garrick, presently Professor of Mechanical Engineering and Associate Vice Provost, Office for Equity and Diversity, University of Minnesota, Minneapolis, as the inaugural Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, on 100 percent time, twelve-month service basis, at an annual salary of \$329,999, which consists of an annual base salary of \$213,888 plus an administrative stipend of \$116,111, beginning July 26, 2019.

Dr. Garrick served as Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Designate from July 16, 2019, through July 25, 2019, under the same conditions and salary arrangement.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes, The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

This recommendation is made with the advice of a search committee.¹
