APPOINT INTERIM DEAN, COLLEGE OF LAW, URBANA

**Action:** Appoint Interim Dean, College of Law, Urbana

**Funding:** State Appropriated Funds

The Chancellor at Urbana has recommended the appointment of Charles J. Tabb, presently Professor and Alice Curtis Campbell Professor, College of Law, as Interim Dean, College of Law, non-tenured, on an academic year service basis, with an administrative increment of \$30,000, effective August 16, 2007. Mr. Tabb will continue to hold the rank of Professor, College of Law, on indefinite tenure, on an academic year service basis, on 100 percent time, at an annual salary of \$191,973; and Alice Curtis Campbell Professor, College of Law, non-tenured, on an academic year service basis, with an increment of \$6,643, for a total salary of \$228,616.

Mr. Tabb succeeds Dean Heidi M. Hurd, who will continue as a full-time Professor in the College of Law.

The board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable state and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes, The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The nomination is made with the advice of the faculty and the Executive Committee of the College.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs.

The President of the University recommends approval.
