APPOINT VICE PRESIDENT FOR HEALTH AFFAIRS

Action: Appoint Vice President for Health Affairs

Funding: State Appropriated Funds

I recommend the appointment of Joe G. N. Garcia, presently Interim Vice President for Health Affairs, University Administration; Earl M. Bane Professor of Medicine, College of Medicine at Chicago; and Vice Chancellor for Research, Chicago, to serve as Vice President for Health Affairs, University Administration, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, on 14 percent time, at an annual salary of \$94,500, and an administrative increment of \$100,000, beginning June 16, 2011.

Dr. Garcia will continue to hold the rank of Professor of Medicine, College of Medicine at Chicago, on indefinite tenure, on a twelve-month service basis, on 80 percent time, at an annual salary of \$540,000, effective June 16, 2011; Vice Chancellor for Research, Chicago, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, on 6 percent time, at an annual salary of \$40,500, effective June 16, 2011; and Earl M. Bane Professor of Medicine, College of Medicine at Chicago, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, on zero percent time, non-salaried, effective February 16, 2011, for a total annual salary of \$775,000. If Dr. Garcia serves as Vice President for Health Affairs through June 2013, he will receive a retention payment of \$100,000 on July 16, 2013; and if he continues to serve through June 2015, he will receive a retention payment of \$100,000 on July 16, 2015.

He was appointed to serve as Interim Vice President for Health Affairs beginning March 28, 2011.
