University of Illinois at Chicago

- Testing a simplified disclosure process for preliminary screening. If screening is positive, information for patent application is collected.
- Testing an expanded screening process employing industry data mining techniques.
 This process should identify more potential licensees and more applications for UIC technologies.
- Issued new guidelines for outside patent counsel including fixed fee billing and caps on charges for provisional application applications.
- Searching for industry reps to engage in revised technology evaluation process.
- Royalty income increased 28% over Q2, 2004.
- Reviewing operating procedures to streamline processes.

University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign

- Webstore sales of software to date total 126; 68 sales in Q2. This is in addition to the number of licenses for FY05 reported in the table below.

- Search is underway for a Technology Manager to replace Brad Roth who left for a high tech company in Lincoln, Nebraska.
- Working with TechEx, an online IP match service. TechEx sends technology listings to subscribers with technology wishlists using categories assigned to each listing.
- Exhibited at three tradeshows in Q2, LES, IBIO Marketplace, and NanoCommerce. Another 4 tradeshows planned for Q3.
- Start-up Dynamic Separations, Inc. (DSI), will be installing their first prototype in an Illinois coal mine. DSI is the first start-up out of the Illinois Geological Society, a unit of the Illinois Department of Natural Resources.
