ELIMINATE THE BACHELOR OF ARTS IN FRENCH BUSINESS STUDIES,
COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS AND SCIENCES, CHICAGO

Action: Approve the Elimination of the Bachelor of Arts in French Business Studies, College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, Chicago

Funding: No Funding Required

The Chancellor at Chicago, with the advice of the Chicago Senate and the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, recommends the elimination of the undergraduate degree, the Bachelor of Arts in French Business Studies.

The Department of Spanish, French, Italian, and Portuguese seeks to eliminate the Bachelor of Arts in French Business Studies because of the lack of student demand. Students interested in combining the study of the French language and culture, along with business skills, have other options available to them.

The board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes*, *The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs with this recommendation. The University Senates Conference has indicated that no further Senate jurisdiction is involved.

The President of the University recommends approval, pending further review by the Illinois Board of Higher Education.
