ELIMINATE THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN LIBERAL ARTS AND SCIENCES  
IN BIOLOGY HONORS, COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS AND SCIENCES,  
URBANA

**Action:** Approve the Elimination of the Bachelor of Science in Liberal Arts and Sciences in Biology Honors, College of Liberal Arts and Sciences

**Funding:** No New Funding Required

The Chancellor at Urbana with the advice of the Urbana-Champaign Senate recommends approval of a proposal from the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences to eliminate the Bachelor of Science in Liberal Arts and Sciences in Biology Honors (B.S.L.A.S.).

The B.S.L.A.S. in Biology Honors was replaced by the Molecular and Cellular Biology Honors and Integrative Biology Honors concentrations approved for the majors in Molecular and Cellular Biology and Integrative Biology. Students admitted after fall 2003 were admitted to the replaced honors concentrations. No students are currently pursuing the Biology Honors major.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and Federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes*, *The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs with this recommendation. The University Senates Conference has indicated that no further Senate jurisdiction is involved.

The President of the University recommends approval. This action is subject to further review and approval by the Illinois Board of Higher Education.
