AWARD CONTRACT FOR WEST CAMPUS TUNNEL RENOVATION, CHICAGO

Action: Approve Award of Contract for West Campus Tunnel Renovation, Chicago

Funding: Certificates of Participation Series 2007A

This \$1,623,000 project will include structural repairs and reconstruction of the East-West tunnel that runs along the south side of the Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Laboratories and the North-South tunnel that runs along the west side of the Clinical Sciences Building and the Neuropsychiatric Institute.

The Chancellor at Chicago with the concurrence of the appropriate administrative officers recommends that the construction contract for the tunnel renovation work be awarded. Competitive bidding procedures in accordance with the Illinois Procurement Code were followed; and the award is to the lowest responsible bidder on the basis of its base bid.
