Online Majors (Spring 2019)

- Online majors 35.6% of UIS (1,494 out of 4,202 students)
- Online majors from:
 - ○84 counties in Illinois
 - 46 states
 - 14 foreign countries
 - ○1 US territory
- Online students are older:
 - 9.4 years for undergrads (32.5 vs 23.1)
 - 5.8 years older for MS (35.3 vs 29.5)
