

## New in 2017

- Regulations and rules having notable impact across the System:
  - Department of Education withdrew certain guidance regarding sexual misconduct
  - The European Union General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which goes into effect May 25, 2018, began to attract attention in the U.S.
  - Illinois Preventing Sexual Violence in Higher Education Act requires new annual report beginning November 2017
  - NCAA announced attestation requirement for chancellors, athletic directors and Title IX coordinators regarding sexual violence prevention. Initial certification due May 15, 2018
- Support the Senior Executive Risk Management Council as University administrators evaluate and address some of the most significant risks to the University

#### Statements and Training

- Statement of Economic Interests and Supplemental Statement of Economic Interest – oversee and review all filings and communications
  - 9,200 employees file paper with the Secretary of State through our office
  - Same 9,200 file electronically with the Executive Ethics Commission
- Annual Ethics Training (BOT, faculty, staff, student employees and new hires – online and classroom)
  - Over 50,000 employees (including over 16,600 seasonal and temporary employees)
  - 99.7% compliance rate

# Training (cont'd)

- Sexual Misconduct Prevention and Reporting Training for Employees
  - Over 40,000 faculty, staff, graduate employees, and resident advisors completed the online training program
  - 99.88% compliance rate
- Sexual Misconduct Prevention and Reporting Training for Students who are enrolled in on-ground courses
  - Just under 40,000 students participated in the annual training program
  - Equivalent to over 80% of new students and 40% of returning students

## Inquiries and Investigations

- Liaison to the Illinois Executive Inspector General (OEIG)
  - 25 cases were referred to the University for internal consideration
  - 7 OEIG data requests were fulfilled
- Internal ethics inquiries/investigations
  - o 64 inquiries
  - 2 significant investigations

#### Compliance Focus Areas

- Sexual Misconduct Prevention and Reporting Clery, VAWA, and Illinois Preventing Sexual Violence in Higher Education Act
  - Regular consultation with all Title IX programs
  - Reviewed UIC and UIUC policies and procedures
  - Reviewed all Annual Security and Fire Safety Reports (Clery reports)
  - Consulted on the first annual sexual misconduct reports due to the Illinois Attorney General on November 1, 2017
  - Facilitated quarterly System-wide Clery coordination working group meetings
  - Monitored drug and alcohol abuse prevention program compliance with federal Drug Free Schools and Campuses Regulations

## Compliance Focus Areas (cont'd)

- HIPAA Privacy & Security Compliance Policy updated
  - President delegated HIPAA program oversight to Executive Director, UECO
  - New HIPAA governance structure implemented through MOU
- European Union General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
  - Introduced stakeholders to GDPR requirements
  - Initiated survey to assess applicability and impact
  - o Collaborating with Privacy and Information Security Officers to facilitate compliance
- Animated Awareness Videos What You Need to Know in 5 Minutes
  - o Partnered with subject matter experts to address key ethics and compliance matters
  - Consulted with various Big 10 and other universities to help them establish 5-minute video programs

## Compliance Focus Areas (cont'd)

- Mapped federal compliance obligations to responsible officials to support compliance and accountability
- Development of structured fraud awareness program
- Continuing compliance efforts
  - System-wide Compliance Advisory Committee bi-monthly
  - UIC Campus Compliance Committee member
  - Role in the development and/or review of System and University policies
  - Coordination with University Audits and Enterprise Risk Management
  - Compliance Officer Network Updates
