AWARD CONTRACTS FOR RENOVATION AND ADDITION, STATE FARM CENTER, URBANA

Action: Award Contracts for Renovation and Addition, State Farm Center

Funding: Institutional Funds Operating Budget with Anticipated Reimbursement

from the Proceeds of a Future sale of Auxiliary Facilities System Bonds

and Gift Funds

In May 2013, the Board of Trustees approved the renovation and addition of the State Farm Center project. This \$165.0 million, 431,340 gross square foot (gsf) proposed renovation and addition project will enhance amenities to improve the experience for attendees and participants during events at the State Farm Center. Major elements of the renovation work may include the addition of guest suites, new bowl seating, added restroom facilities, replacement of mechanical systems and controls to include air conditioning of the facility, replacement of building lighting and controls, replacement of the electrical distribution system, addressing code and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements and enlarging the concourse for added circulation, restroom, and concession space.

In November and December 2013, the Board approved the first phase of the construction work, which included Division 1--General Work, Division 2--Plumbing

Work, Division 3--Heating Work, Division 4--Ventilation Work, Division 5--Electrical Work, Division 15--Concrete Work, Division 16--Demolition Work, Division 34--Site Utilities Work, Division 18--Excavation Work; and Division 27--Site Work. Bids for the second phase of the construction work have been solicited and for the project to proceed, the Chancellor, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and the Vice President, University of Illinois with the concurrence of the appropriate administrative officers recommends that the following contracts¹ be awarded. Competitive bidding procedures in accordance with the Illinois Procurement Code were followed; and the awards are to the lowest responsible bidder for each division on the basis of its base bid plus the acceptance of indicated alternates²:
