

Associate Professor in History (Springfield)


- Recognized leading scholar in Hellenistic history, archaeology, epigraphy (study of inscriptions), and numismatics (study of coins)

Cynthia Oliver


Professor in Dance (Urbana-Champaign)

Distinguished Professor in Bioprocessing, Agricultural and Biological Engineering (Urbana-Champaign)


- Internationally recognized as an authority in corn processing

Youngjin Kang Assistant Professor in Child & Family Studies




- PhD at University of Missouri Columbia in Human Development & Family Science

Ksenija Glusac Associate Professor in Chemistry




- PhD from University of Florida, currently tenured associate professor at Bowling Green University in photochemistry






