UIAA BOARD MEETINGS

The University of Illinois Alumni Association Board of Directors recently met in Washington, D.C. In addition to the meeting, Board members participated in several additional activities. UIAA Board member and C-SPAN co-President Rob Kennedy hosted the group for a tour of the C-SPAN studio. Illinois delegation staff members – all Illinois natives and/or alumni of the University of Illinois – participated in a panel discussion and shared their perspectives on issues and trends, specifically related to higher education, from Capitol Hill. Each of the panelists provided insights, strategies and good advice for our members on how to be effective advocates for the University.

During the Board meeting, Committee members shared updates about Board business and UIAA operations, including a financial performance summary, UIAA tactical plan and the progress on the development of the University of Illinois Welcome Center. Action taken by the Board included the approval of the recommendation of the Student Alumni Ambassadors (SAA) working group to transfer management of the student organization from UIAA to the Urbana campus, while continuing to maintain a strong partnership between UIAA and SAA on student-to-alumni programming. Additionally, the Board heard University updates from University of Illinois President Tim Killeen, University Trustee Jill Smart, UI Foundation President & CEO Jim Moore, Office of Governmental Relations Executive Director Lindsay Anderson; affinity program partners University of Illinois Community Credit Union and Cozad Asset Management and U.S. Senator Dick Durbin.



Following the meeting, UIAA life members, DC Illini Club members, and Illinois Connection advocates joined the Board for a cocktail reception to connect, inspire and celebrate University of Illinois alumni. Loren Taylor presented the Loyalty Award for Exceptional Alumni Service to Burt Wagner for his dedication and service to the Illinois Alumni Club of Greater Washington, D.C.

The June Board meeting will be held in conjunction with a Board retreat **June 23-24** at the Q Center in St. Charles, IL. During the retreat, the Board will develop strategies and action items designed to meet UIAA goals. An alumni reception will be held **June 23** at Hotel Baker in St. Charles.

LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY ACTIVITY

The Advocacy Consortium of Public Illinois Alumni Associations met **April 28** at Northern Illinois University's Naperville campus. Guest speakers included Senator Pat McGuire, Chair of the Senate Higher Education Committee and Representative Kelly Burke, Chair of the House Higher Education Committee. They shared suggestions on how to tell impactful stories to legislators to enhance our advocacy efforts. The consortium will reconvene in the summer to outline strategies and action items to elevate our message that higher education is part of the solution to the state's challenges.

ILLINOIS ALUMNI INSIDERS

The UIAA recently launched *Illinois Alumni Insiders*, an insight community that will allow us to better connect and engage with young alumni. We currently have 192 members enrolled in the program, and 75% of those members have completed the Welcome Survey. Participants have the opportunity to provide feedback about existing and proposed UIAA programs and services; offer insights into what young alumni are seeking from their alumni association; and test the marketing of messages, images and campaigns.
