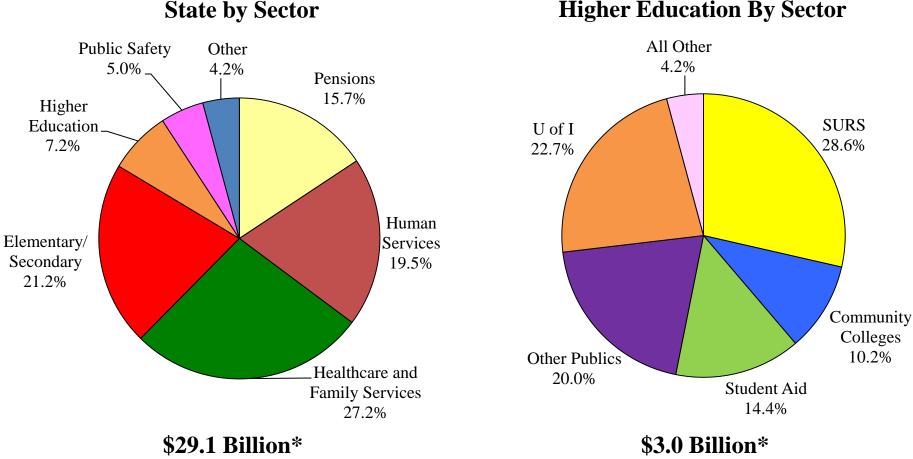

**Higher Education By Sector** 

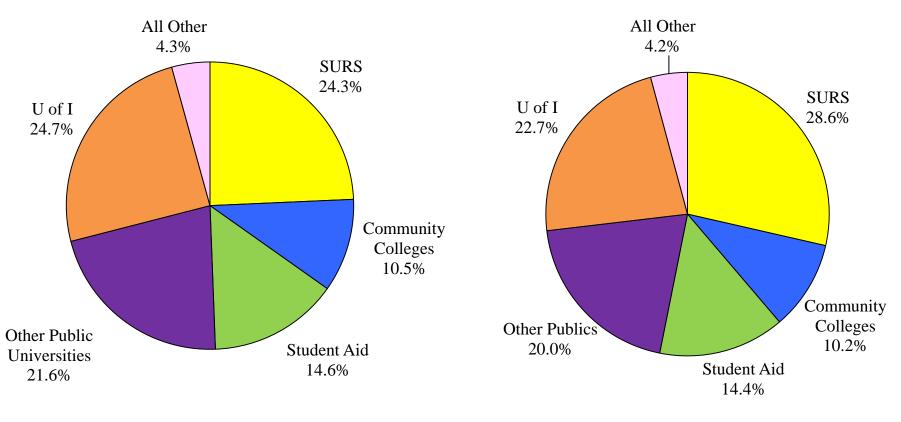

#### State of Illinois Higher Education Budget by Sector Fiscal Year 2010 vs Fiscal Year 2011



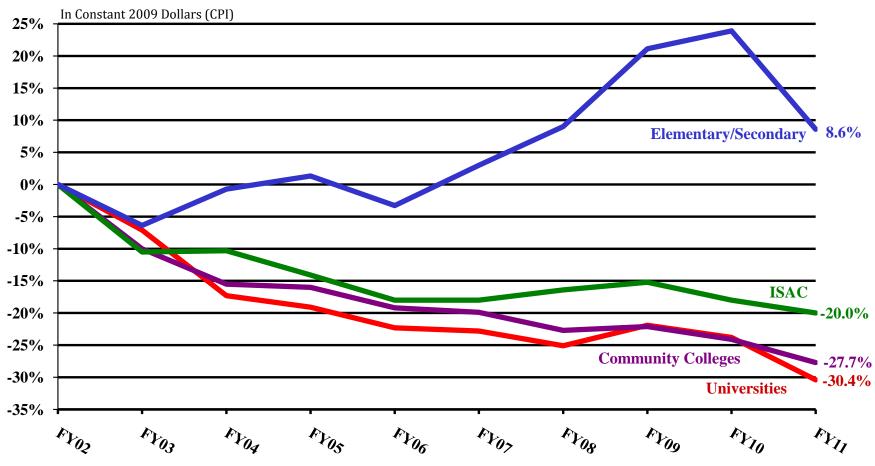

FY02 – FY11 exclude \$45 million from higher education for Health Insurance payment to CMS.

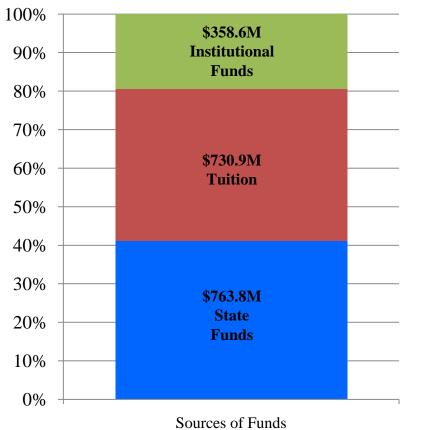

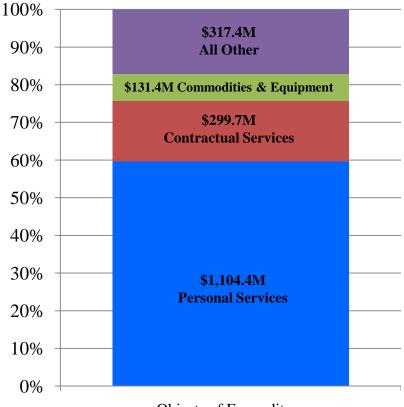

Where Do the Dollars Go? FY 2010



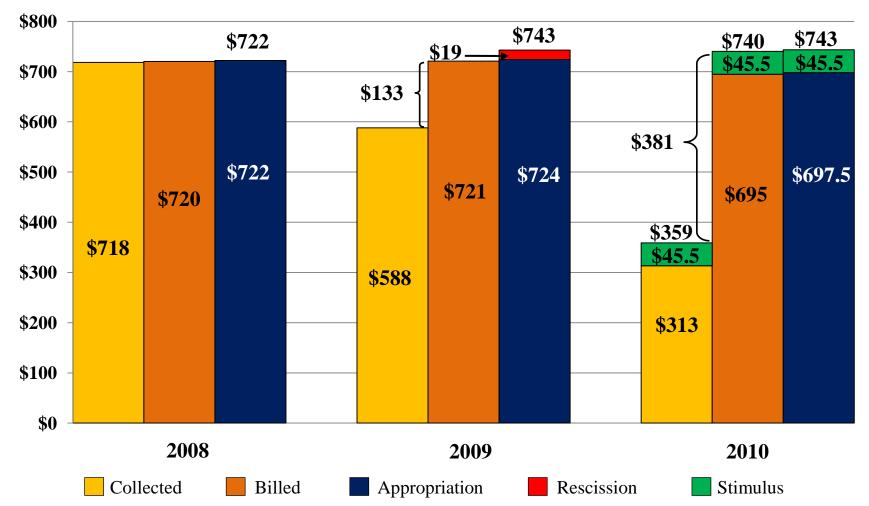

#### State Appropriation Revenue Unrestricted Funds Billings and Collections through May 17, 2010



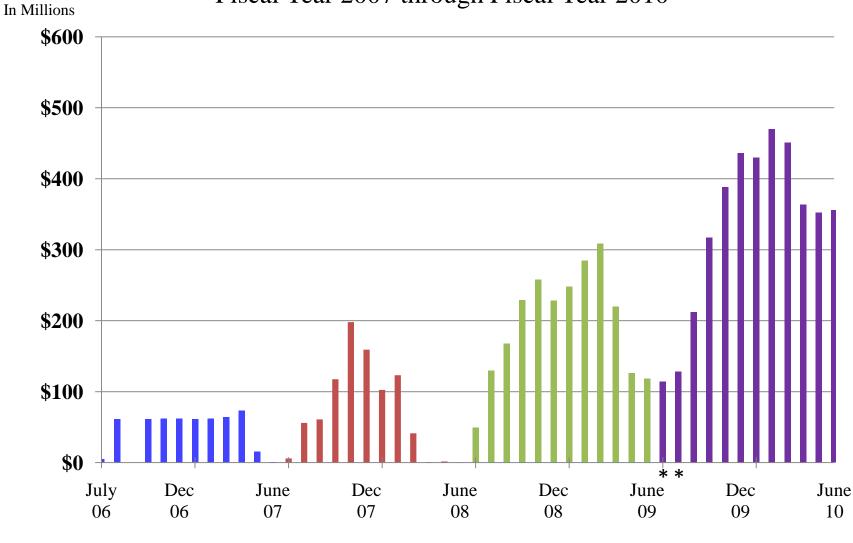

Fiscal Year 2007 through Fiscal Year 2010



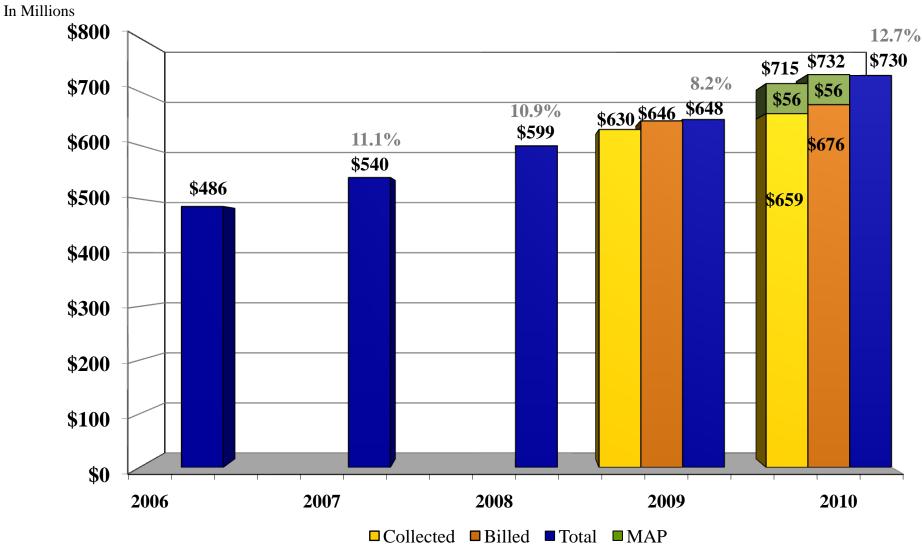
Month End General Revenue Fund Receivable

# Income Fund (Tuition) Revenue

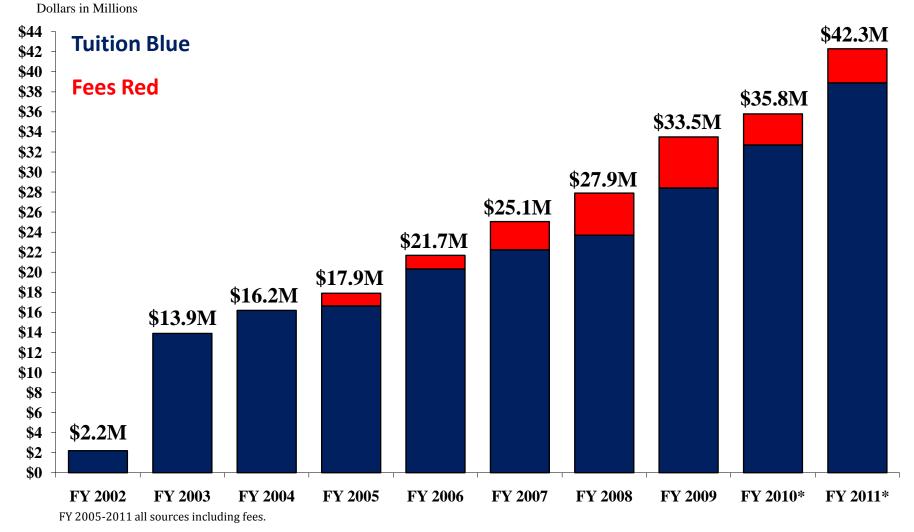

## University of Illinois Supplemental Financial Aid Expenditures FY 2000 - FY 2011

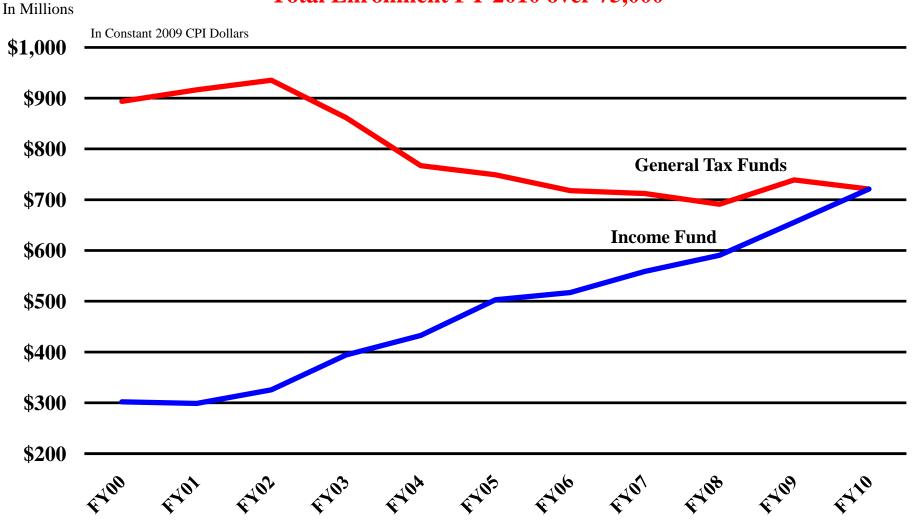

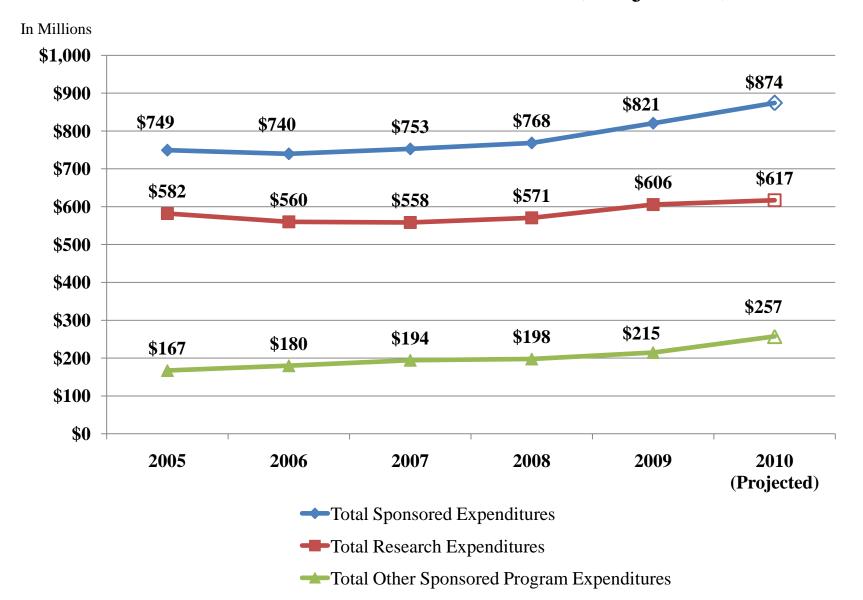

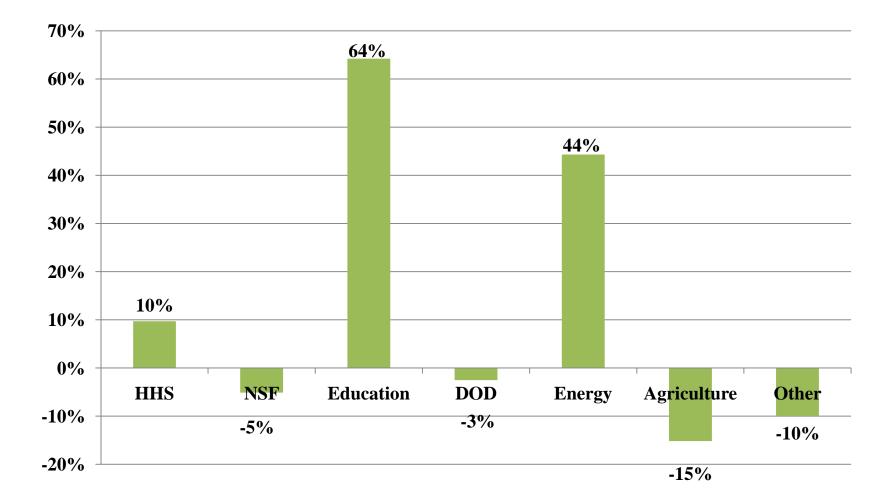

# Change in Federal Expenditures by Agency FY2009 to FY2010 (Projected)



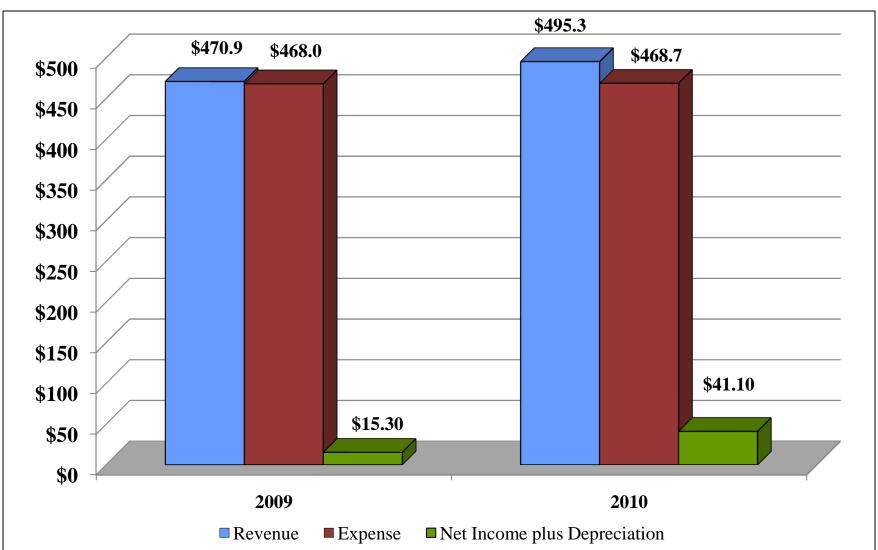

Fiscal Year 2009 versus Fiscal Year 2010 through March 31

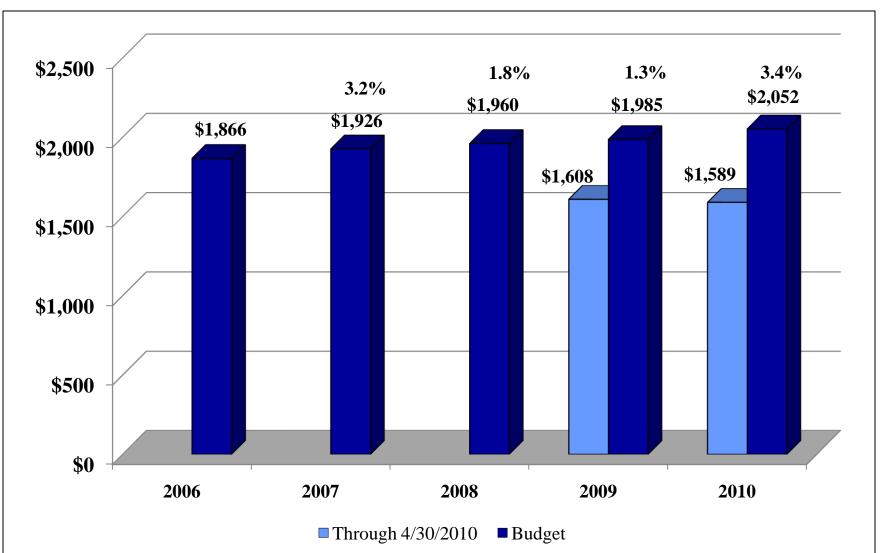
