APPROVE TUITION RATE, MASTER OF ENGINEERING IN BIOINSTRUMENTATION, COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND THE GRADUATE COLLEGE, ACADEMIC YEAR 2015-16, URBANA

Action: Approve Tuition Rate, Master of Engineering in Bioinstrumentation,

College of Engineering and the Graduate College, Academic Year 2015-16

Funding: No New Funding Required

The Chancellor, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and Vice President, University of Illinois recommends approval of the tuition rate for the Master of Engineering in Bioinstrumentation in the College of Engineering and the Graduate College for the Academic Year 2015-16. The total rate of \$39,850 for the program will be assessed to students who enter in Fall 2015. This is a three-term program with Fall and Spring assessments of \$16,000 and \$7,850 for Summer. Tuition revenues will be sufficient to cover the projected academic program costs. This recently approved self-supporting program is intended for industry-based engineering professionals who seek to develop their technical breadth and depth in fields related to biomedical imaging, life science research tools, disease diagnostic technology, DNA sequencing technology and systems engineering.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes*,

The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs with this recommendation.

The President of the University recommends approval.
