Action: Approve the Redesignation of the Department of General Engineering as

the Department of Industrial and Enterprise Systems Engineering in the

College of Engineering, Urbana

Funding: No Funding Required

The Chancellor at Urbana with the advice of the Urbana-Champaign Senate recommends for approval a proposal from the College of Engineering to redesignate the Department of General Engineering as the Department of Industrial and Enterprise Systems Engineering.

As a result of the proposed transfer of the Industrial Engineering program to the Department of General Engineering, the Department of General Engineering will be redesignated as the Department of Industrial and Enterprise Systems Engineering.

The intersection of industrial engineering with enterprise systems engineering creates a natural environment for a single academic department that will establish national and international preeminence.

The board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and Federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes, The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The Vice President for Academic Affairs concurs in this recommendation.

The University Senates Conference has indicated that no further Senate jurisdiction is involved.

The President of the University recommends approval, pending further review by the Illinois Board of Higher Education.
