Action: Appoint Interim Chancellor

Funding: State Appropriated Operating Budget

After consultation with the Senate at Springfield and with campus officers concerning an Interim Chancellor to serve following the retirement of Chancellor Richard D. Ringeisen on October 31, 2010, I am pleased to recommend the appointment of Harry J. Berman, presently Provost and Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, and Professor of Human Services at the Springfield campus, as Interim Chancellor, beginning November 1, 2010, on a twelve-month salary of \$176,054, plus an administrative increment of \$35,209, for a total of \$211,254. Dr. Berman will hold this position until a permanent chancellor is named and prepared to assume responsibilities, following a national search.

Dr. Berman will continue to hold the rank of Professor of Human Services on indefinite tenure on an academic service basis at zero percent time.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes*, *The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.
