APPROVE REVOCATION OF DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY DEGREE, CHICAGO

Action: Approve Revocation of Doctor of Philosophy Degree

Funding: No New Funding Required

The Graduate College at Chicago has conducted a thorough review of a matter concerning conduct by a former student who had received a Doctor of Philosophy Degree in History. The college provided the former student with appropriate due process rights, including notice, and the right to a hearing and appeal. The former student chose not to participate in the process. A committee of three graduate faculty members conducted an initial review and recommended initiation of the degree revocation process; the Interim Dean of the Graduate College reviewed the matter and recommended to the Chancellor that the degree be revoked.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and Federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes*, *The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

The President of the University concurs.
