APPOINT INTERIM VICE PRESIDENT FOR ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

Action: Appoint Interim Vice President for Academic Affairs

Funding: State Appropriated Funds

I recommend the appointment of Marilyn M.M. Marshall, presently Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs, as Interim Vice President for Academic Affairs, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, with a monthly administrative increment of \$3,000, beginning September 8, 2016. It is anticipated that Dr. Marshall will serve in this capacity until a new permanent Vice President for Academic Affairs is named following an internal search process. She has served as Interim Vice President for Academic Affairs Designate under the same terms and conditions since August 22, 2016.

Dr. Marshall will continue to serve as Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs, Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, on 100 percent time, with an annual salary of \$143,916.75. Along with the above referenced stipend, Dr. Marshall's total annual compensation will be \$179,916.75.

She succeeds Vice President for Academic Affairs Christophe Pierre, who departed the University of Illinois to become Provost and Vice President for Academic

Affairs at Stevens Institute of Technology in Hoboken, New Jersey, effective August 22, 2016.

The Board action recommended in this item complies in all material respects with applicable State and federal laws, University of Illinois *Statutes, The General Rules Concerning University Organization and Procedure*, and Board of Trustees policies and directives.

This recommendation is made following consultation with members of the University Senates Conference.
