AWARD CONTRACT FOR WOOD STREET/ ROOSEVELT ROAD PARKING LOT, CHICAGO

Action: Approve Award of Contract for Wood Street/Roosevelt Road Parking Lot,

Chicago

Funding: Auxiliary Facilities System Series 1999 Revenue Bonds

A \$1,574,900 project has been approved to construct a new surface parking lot on the southwest corner of Roosevelt Road and Wood Street. The parking lot will provide 134 total parking spaces including 6 accessible spaces for faculty, staff, and visitors of the west campus and University of Illinois Medical Center. The project will include lighting, landscaping, fencing, and access control equipment.

The Chancellor at Chicago with the concurrence of the appropriate administrative officers recommends that the following contract be awarded. Competitive bidding procedures in accordance with the Illinois Procurement Code were followed; and the award is to the lowest responsible bidders on the basis of its base bid plus the acceptance of indicated alternates.¹

¹Description of Alternates: No alternates were accepted.
