REPORT OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF WOLCOTT, WOOD AND TAYLOR, INC.

- Mark I. Rosenblatt, M.D., Ph.D., M.B.A., Professor and Head, Department of Ophthalmology and Visual Science, Clinical Department Head (selected by the Executive Committee of the College of Medicine Medical Service Plan (MSP) with a term ending June 11, 2019);
- Avijit Ghosh, Ph.D., Chief Executive Officer, University of Illinois Hospital and Clinics (selected by the VCHA for a one year term ending June 30, 2018);

- Patrick Tranmer, M.D., Co-Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs, College of Medicine, and MSP Executive Director (selected by the VCHA for a one year term ending June 30, 2018); and
