Ethics Case Load - 2013

92 new concerns received and reviewed

- 47 required detailed review, collaboration, investigation, follow-up, etc.
 - Additionally, 3 significant concerns carried-over from 2012
- 14 data requests from the Executive Inspector General for the Agencies of the Illinois Governor (OEIG)
- 3 subpoenas involving thousands of pages
- 13 referrals for investigation from the OEIG
- 4 resource intense cases

Ethics Case Load - 2013

Ethics Cases (cont'd)

- 45 required only limited resources for follow-up
- In addition to formal concerns and cases:

Ethics Training

Compliance rates of over 99.9% again in 2013

- 49,100 employees completed annual training
- 14,700 completed new hire ethics orientation
- 8 employees remain noncompliant at March 4, 2014

Developed and provided high-level administrative support to all Illinois public universities on a fee-based contract
