## Ethics Case Load - 2012

- Ethics Cases
  - 92 total cases/concerns reviewed
    - 61 concerns received required detailed review, collaboration, investigation, follow-up, etc.
      - 17 data requests from outside agencies
        - » Over 26 gig of email and over 4,200 document pages
      - 18 referrals for investigation from the Executive Inspector General for the Agencies of the Illinois Governor
      - 1 high profile case resulting in a public report
      - 5 very large cases with respect to resources
        - » Over 33 gig of email reviewed
        - » Over 20,000 document pages reviewed

  - 31 additional concerns were received and addressed but did not require extensive resources
