


- State FY 2016 budget remains at an impasse
- Legislature approved a "stop-gap" appropriation of \$169 million for the University and \$11 million for the Hospital from the Education Assistance Fund on April 22nd
- Billed the State for full \$169 million on April 26th and has received two payments totaling \$91 million
- Received \$31.4 million for Fall Monetary Assistance Program awards on April 25th
- Senate Bill 2048 would provide an additional \$173 million to the University for FY 2016 to be acted on by the House
- Closed \$20.6 million Auxiliary System Revenue Bond financing on April 22nd for the Springfield Student Union Project maintained existing credit ratings
- State payments of managed care Medicaid claims remain in jeopardy


Billings and Collections through May 16, 2016



Hospital Revenue/Expense/Net Income Fiscal Year 2014 - 2016 through March 31st




Big Ten University Credit Rating with Corresponding State Rating




Big Ten Comparison Total Revenues by Contribution FY 2015




Big Ten Comparison Total Cash & Investments FY 2015



Days Cash on Hand FY 2015




Unrestricted Financial Resources-to-OperationsEX 2015




Total Direct Debt FY 2015




Average Debt Service Coverage (x) FY 2015
