UIC has new leadership in the Graduate College charged with developing initiatives to improve the graduate education experience.


### Indicator 1 – Affordable Access UIC Provides Affordable Access

The Board has a long-standing commitment to tuition affordability: "student access to the University of Illinois is a high priority, tuition decisions are made in relationship to financial aid policy and resources, with the goal of minimizing financial barriers for all admitted students."

In 2010, the Board reaffirmed its commitment to access stating that, "the University maintains the goal of ensuring access for qualified students, regardless of financial circumstance."

Affordable access is critically important today. Decreases in State support have resulted in significant increases in tuition.

Excellence at a major research university like UIC is manifested in many ways. None is more important than the quality of the instruction we provide for our students.



#### What can we expect in the future:


- UIC will continue to monitor the distribution of its resources to ensure that we support the instructional mission.





- Six-year graduation rates for underrepresented students at the peer median


## Goal 2 Foster Diversity




## Grow our Translational, Entrepreneurial and Engaged Research and Discovery Enterprise


# Indicator 9 – STEM and Health Graduates UIC will sustain its Production of Graduates in High Demand Fields



Decreasing State support challenges our ability to fulfill our missions. We continue to identify creative solutions and alternatives to be more cost effective and to identify new sources of revenue.


