



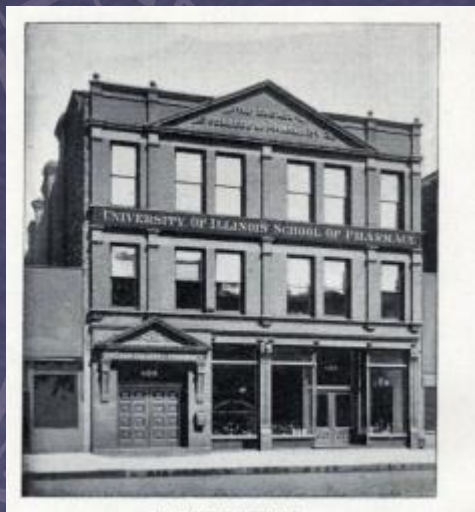

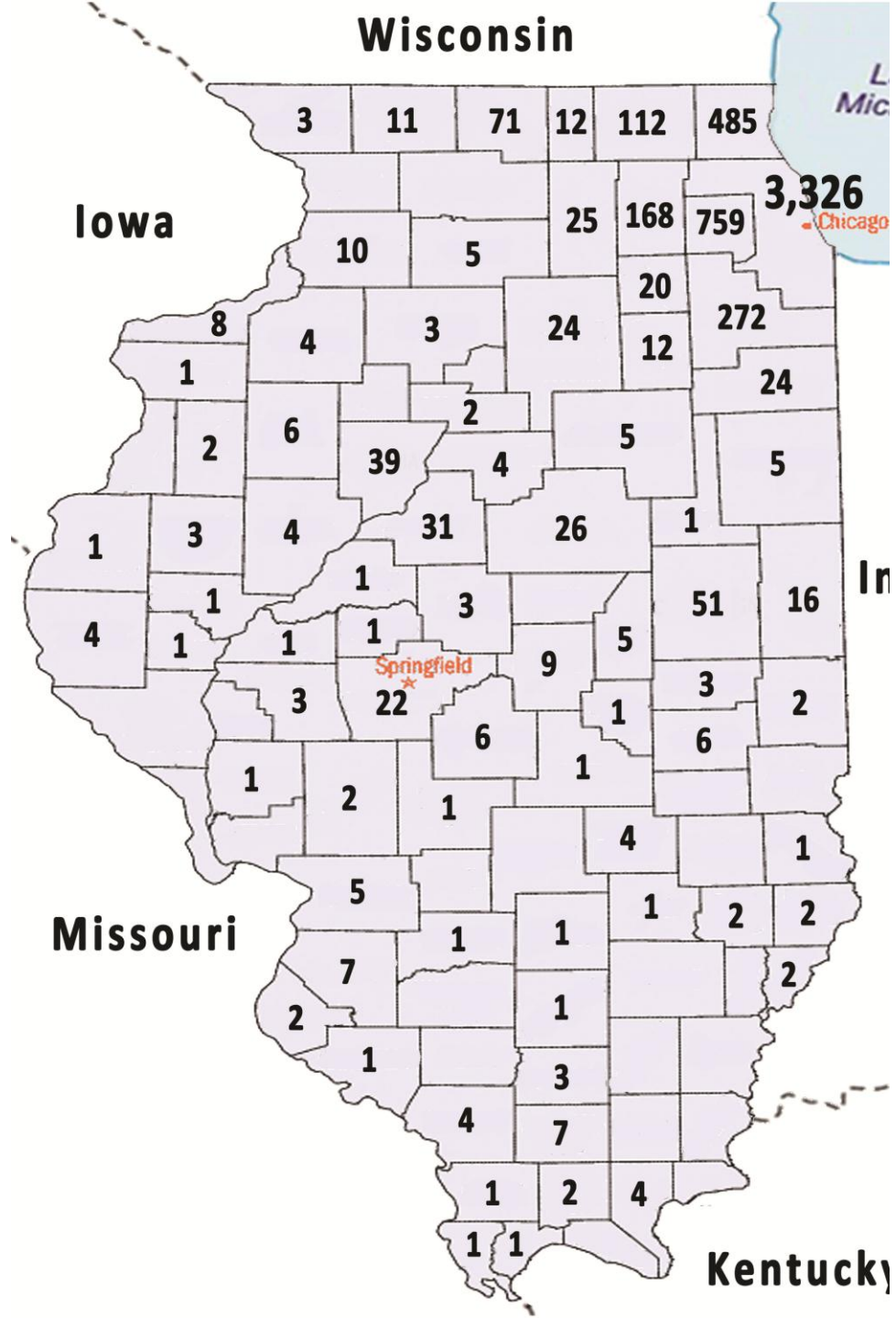
History

- **1982 UIC College of Pharmacy**

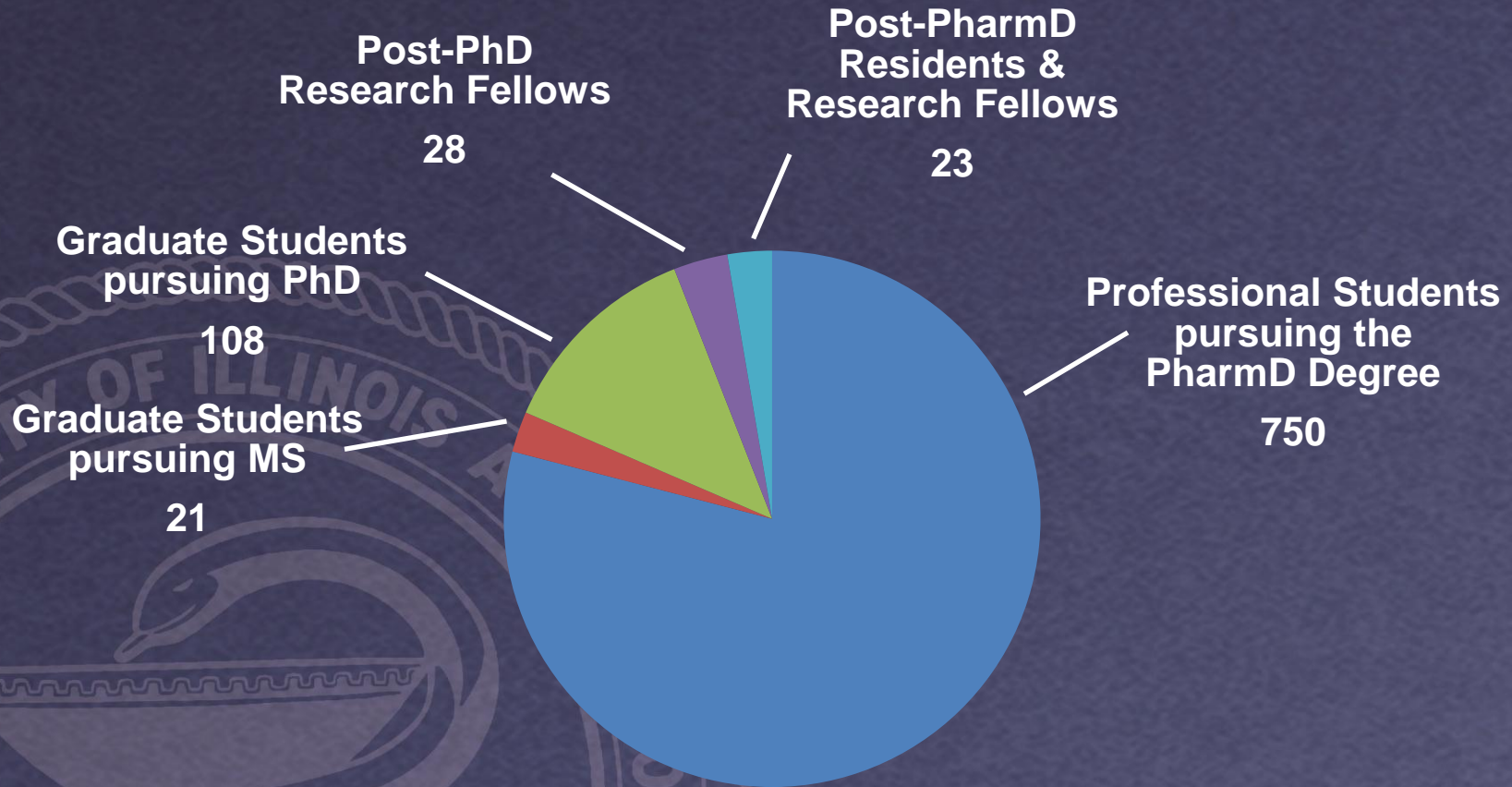


Quick Facts

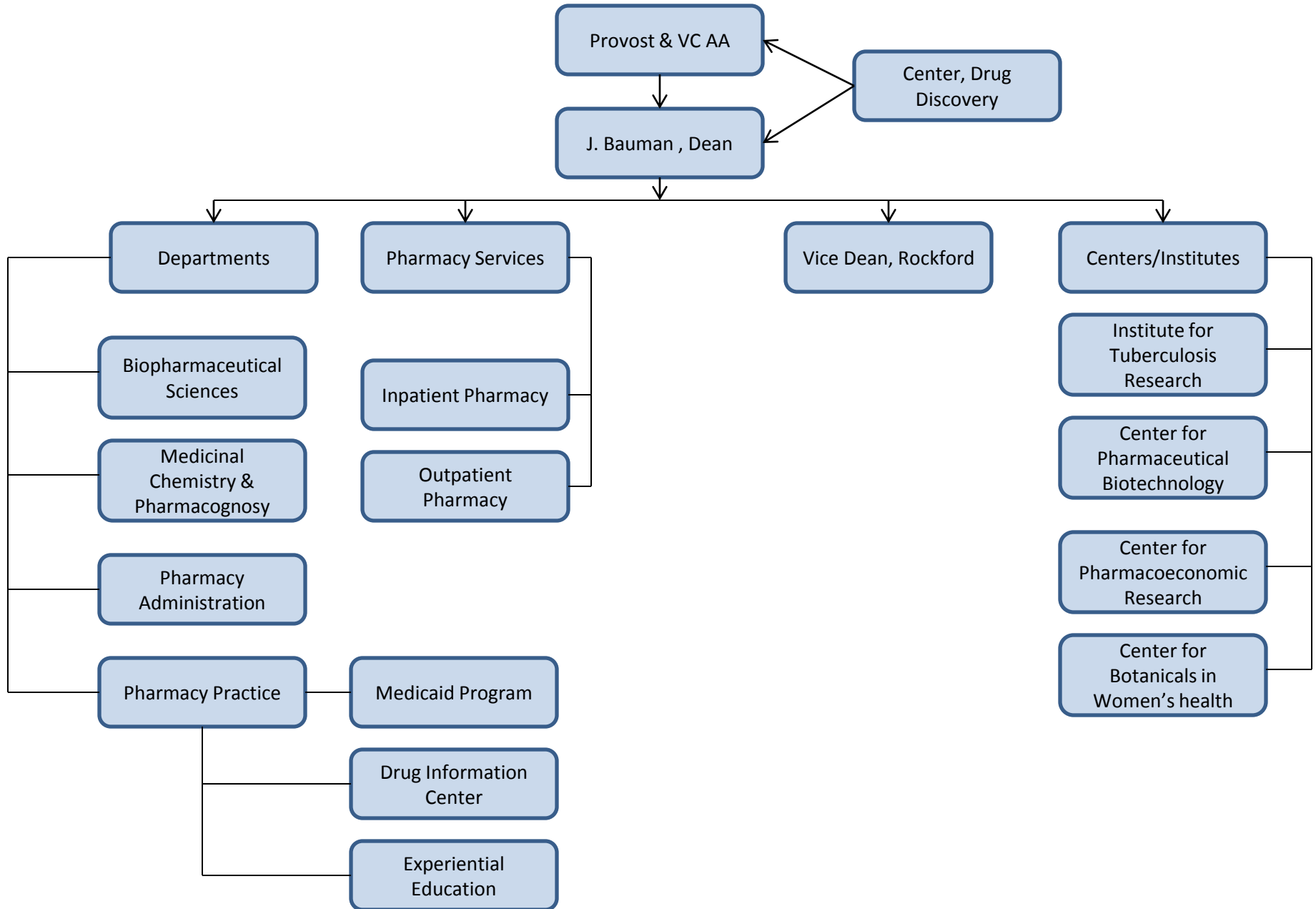

Clinical Services

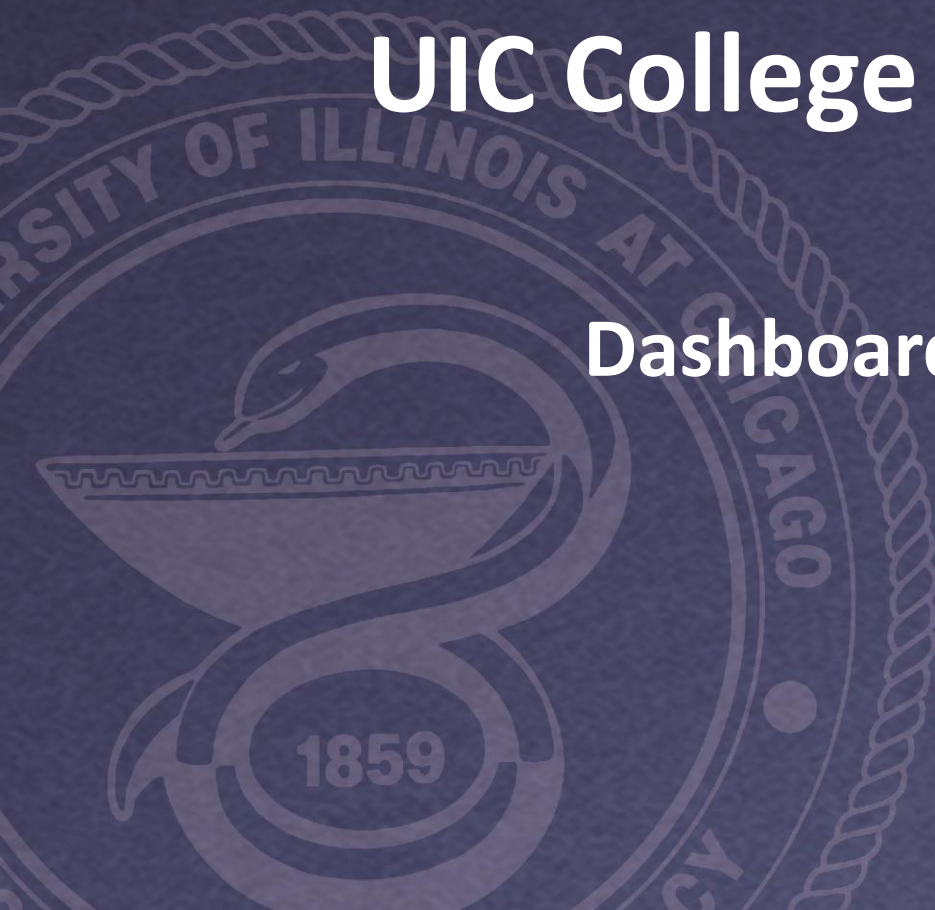
- Largest most comprehensive clinical faculty in the nation
- The College operates inpatient and 7 outpatient pharmacies within the HSC

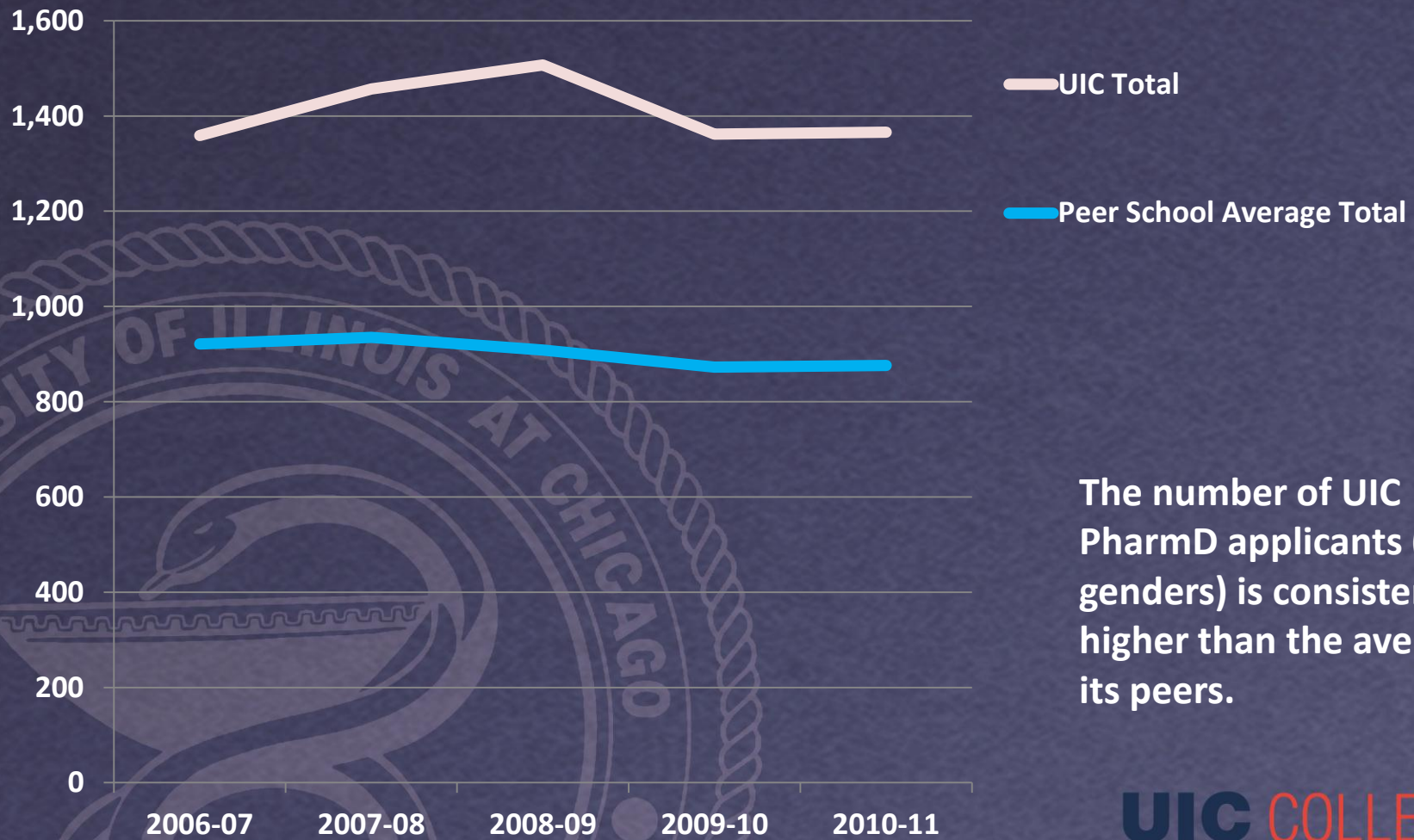

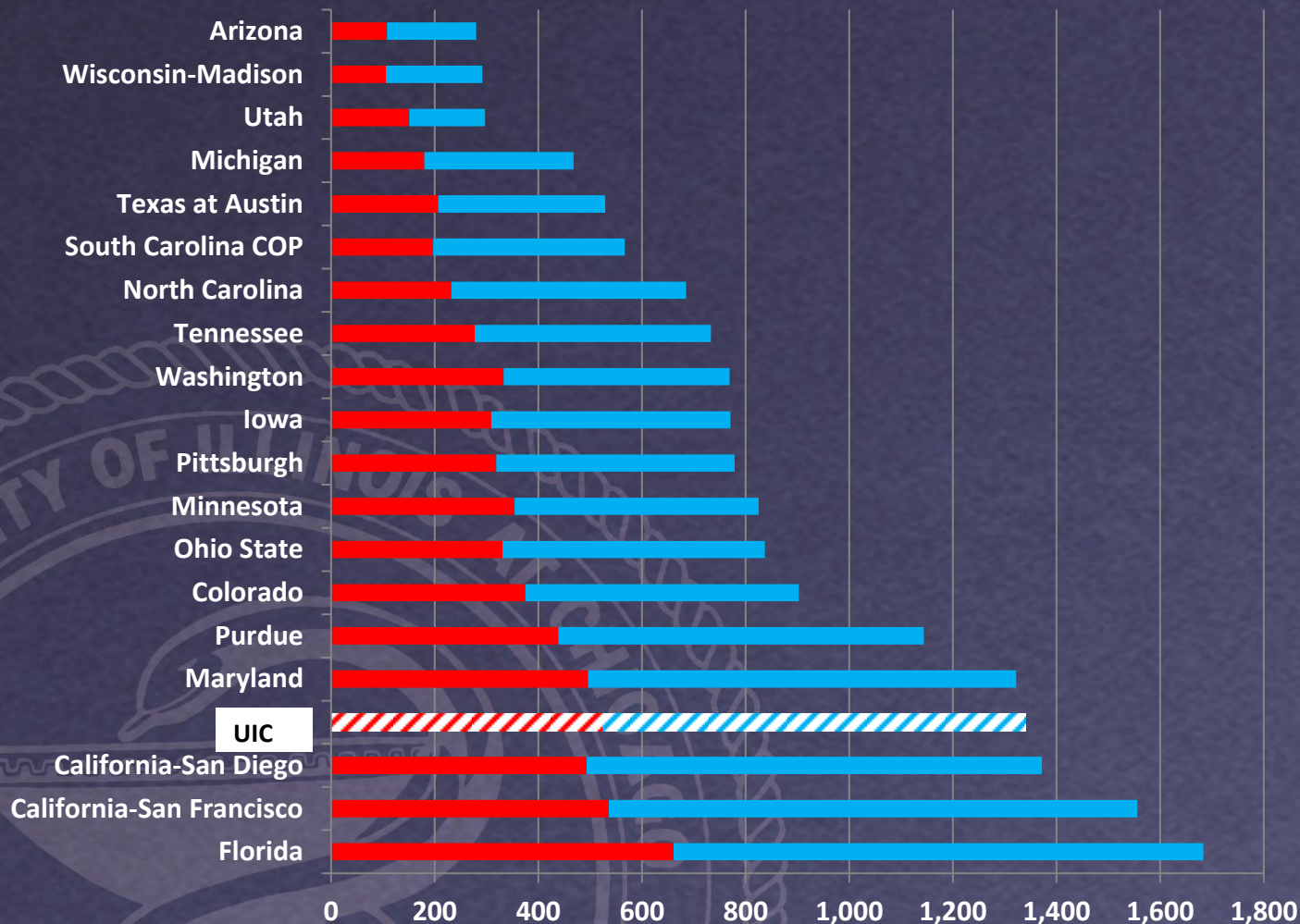

The number of UIC PharmD applicants (both genders) is consistently higher than the average of its peers.

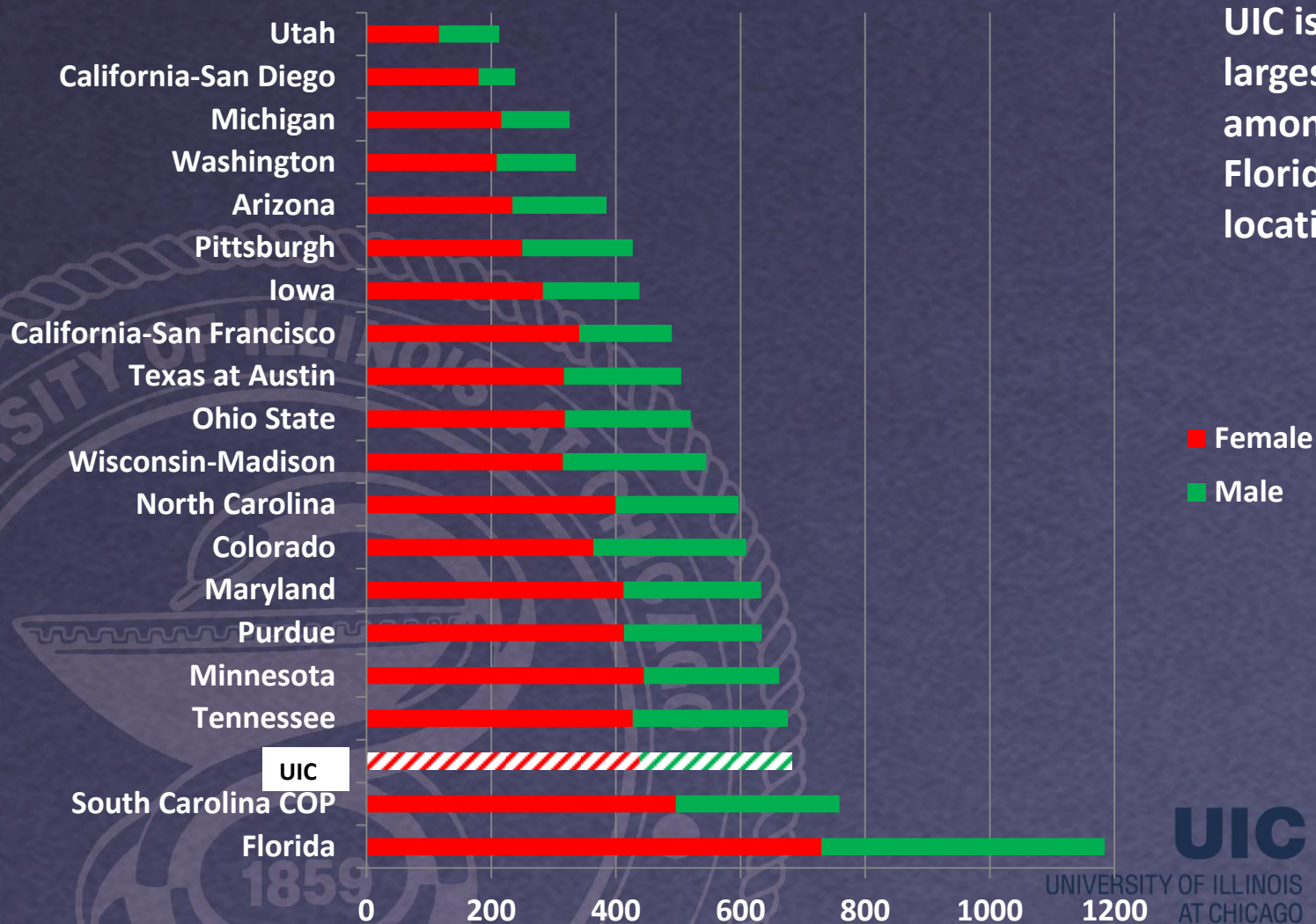
PharmD Applicants by Gender, 2009-10

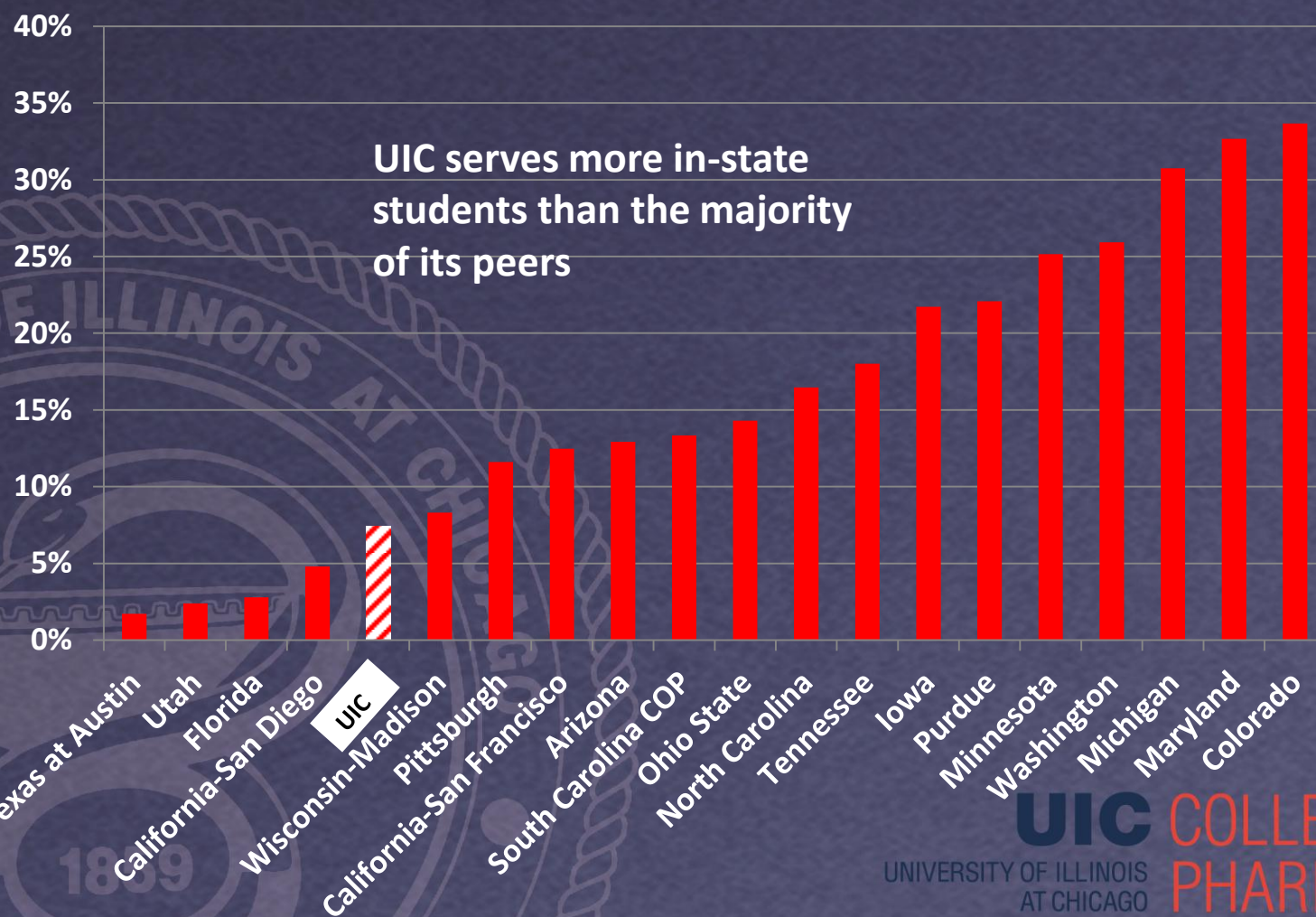

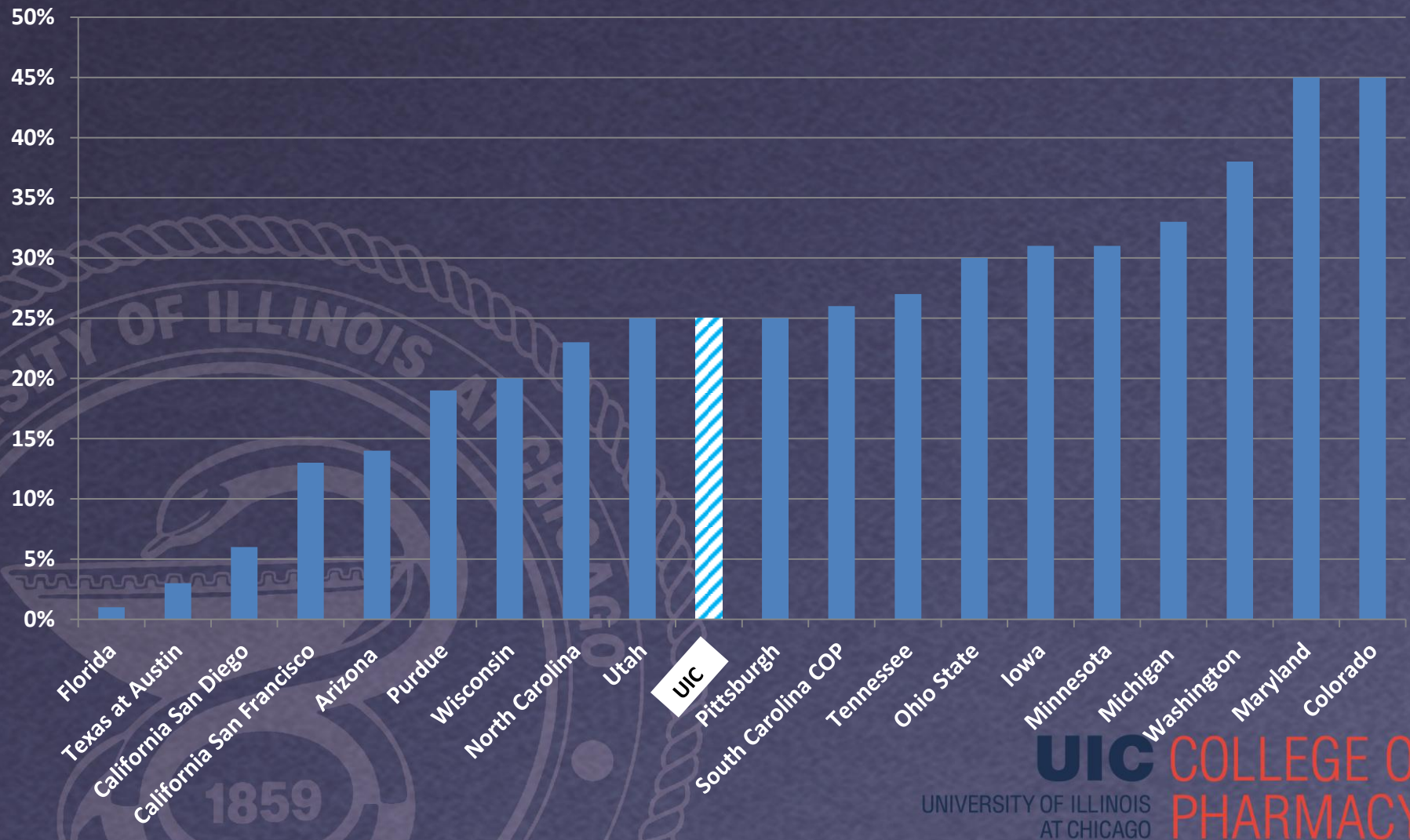

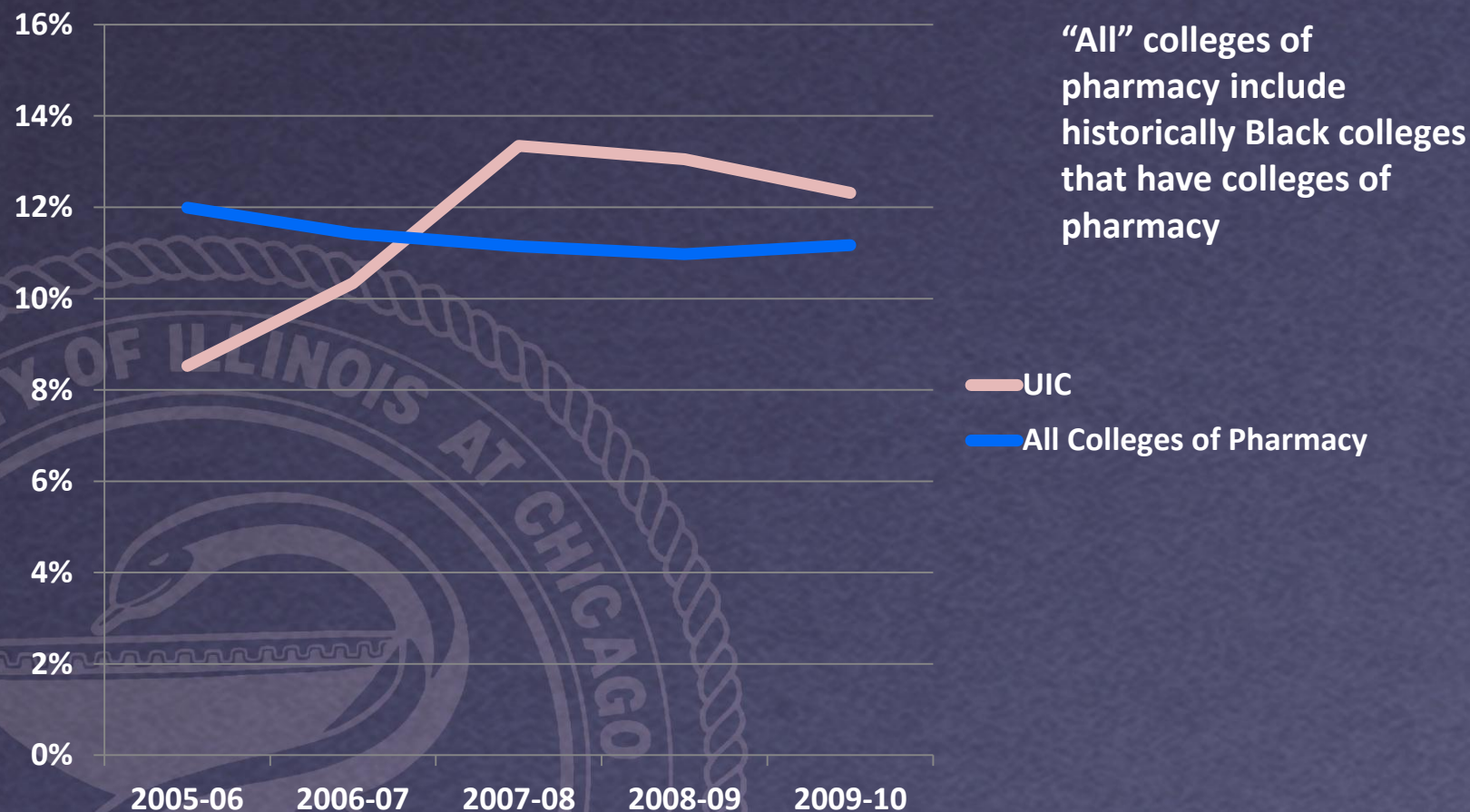
Average Percentage of Out of State PharmD Students, AY 2011



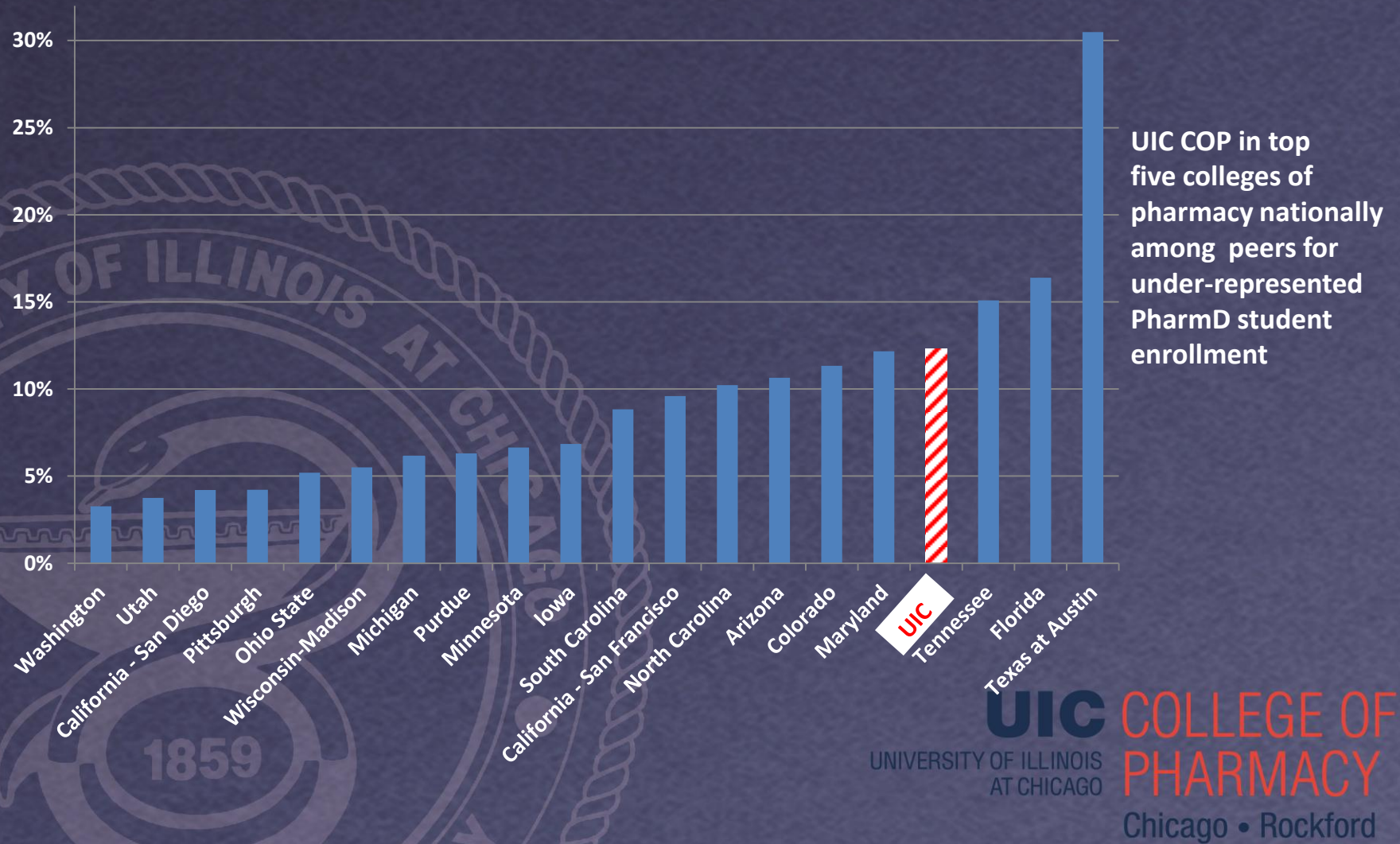
Percentage of Out of State PharmD Students, AY11 Incoming Class



Percentage of Enrolled PharmD Students who are Underrepresented Minorities

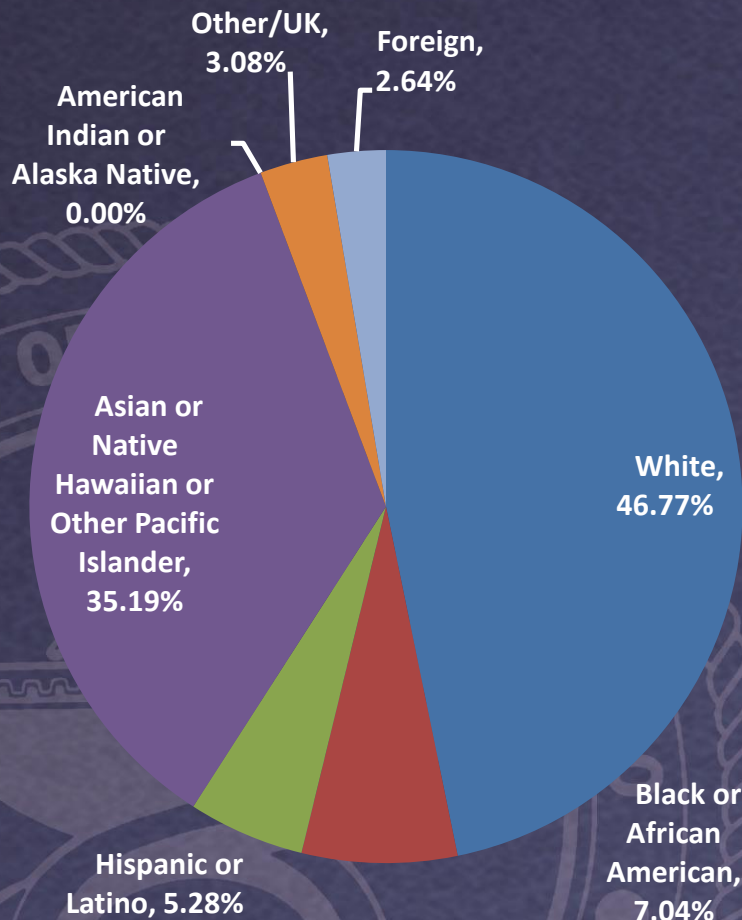


Percentage of Enrolled PharmD Students who are Underrepresented Minorities, 2009-2010

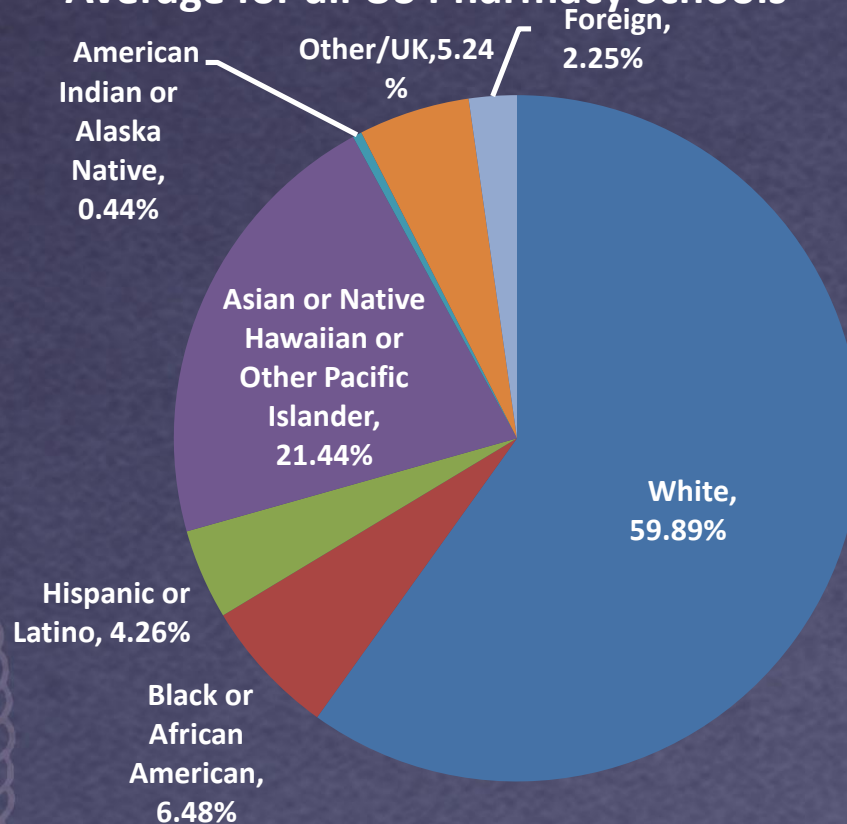


PharmD Student Ethnicity: 2009-2010

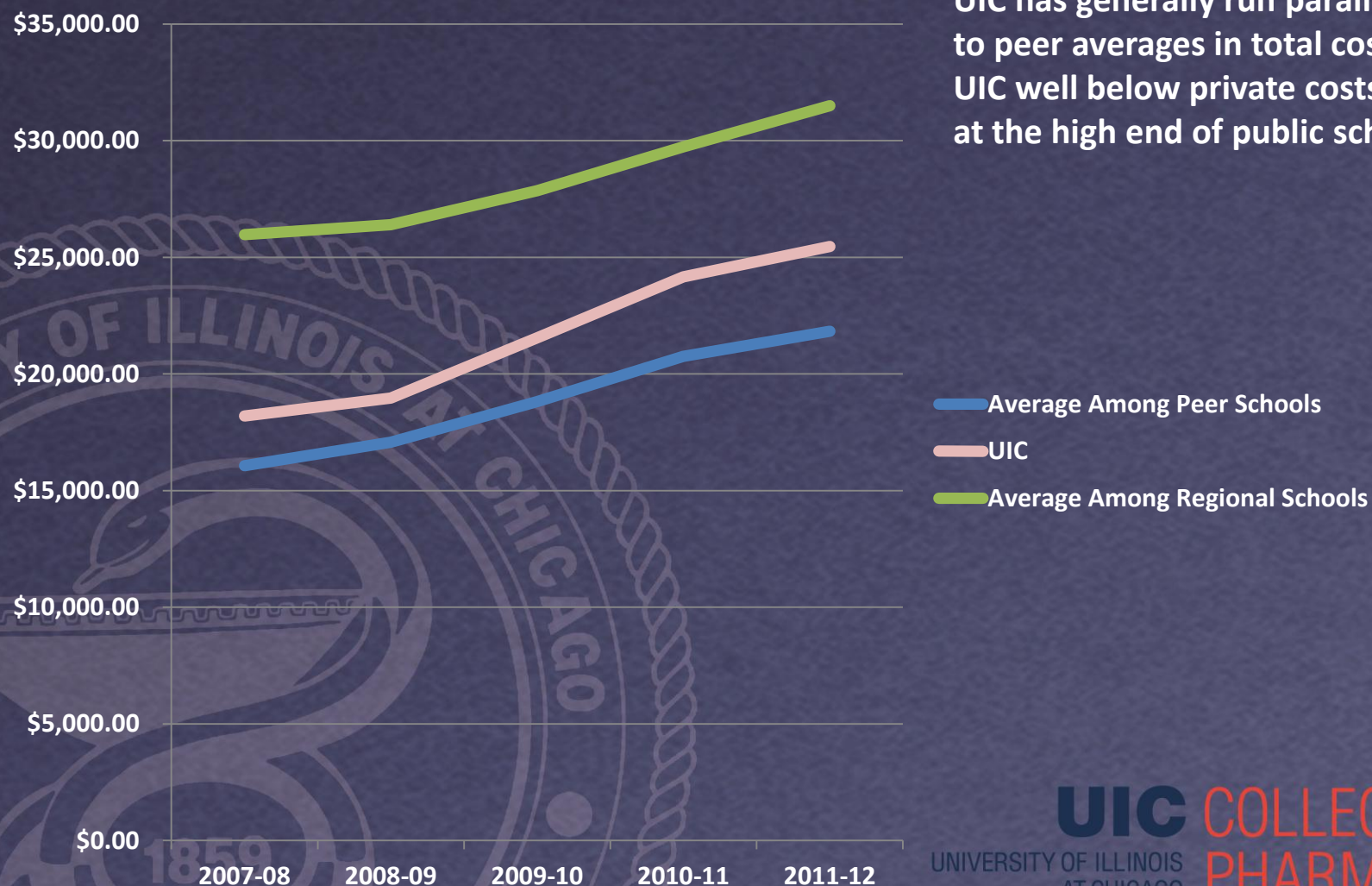
Average for all US Pharmacy Schools



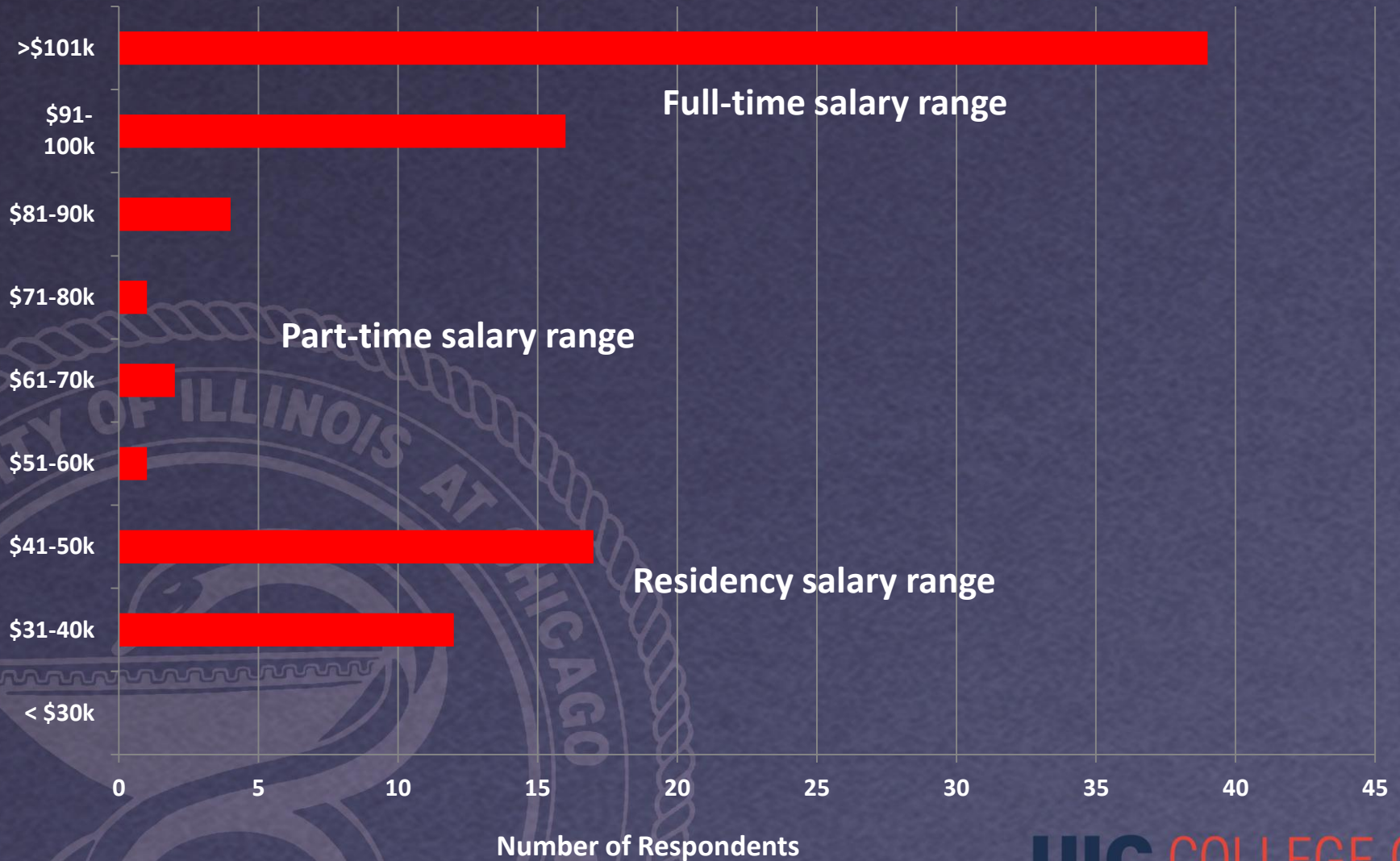
UIC is more ethnically diverse than the average of all US schools

PharmD In-state Tuition & Fees per Year

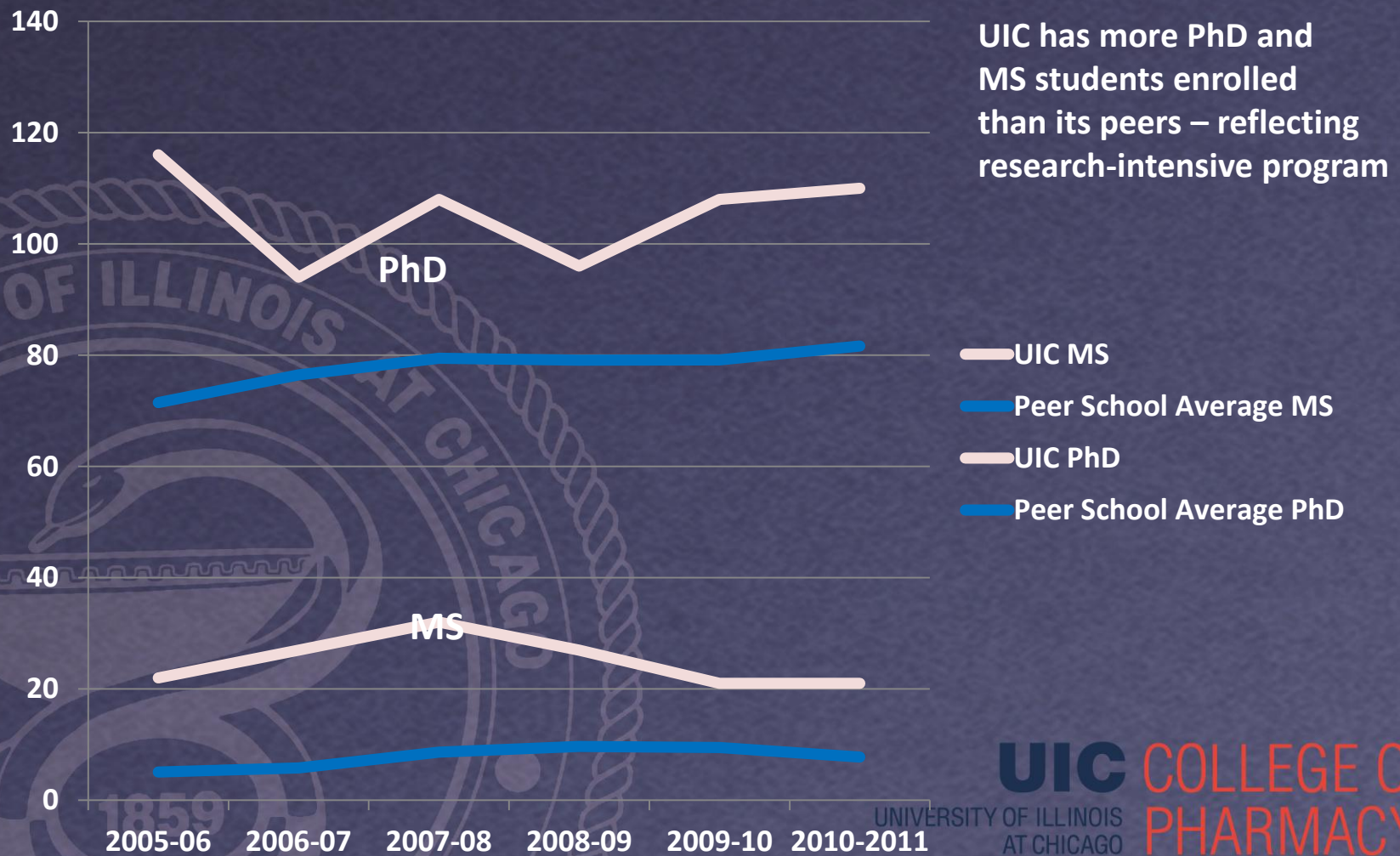
UIC has generally run parallel to peer averages in total cost. UIC well below private costs but at the high end of public schools



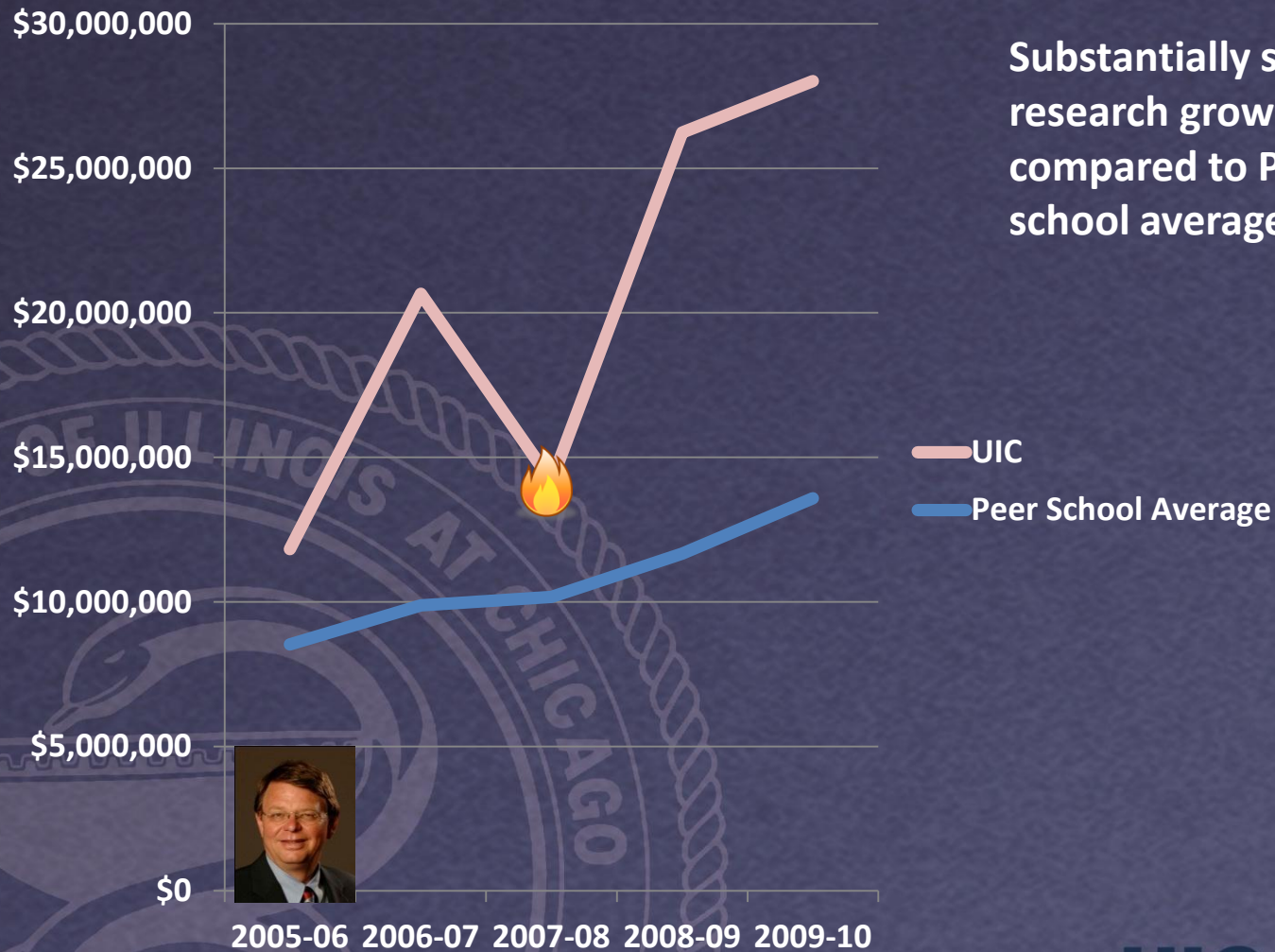
2011 PharmD Graduate Starting Annual Salary



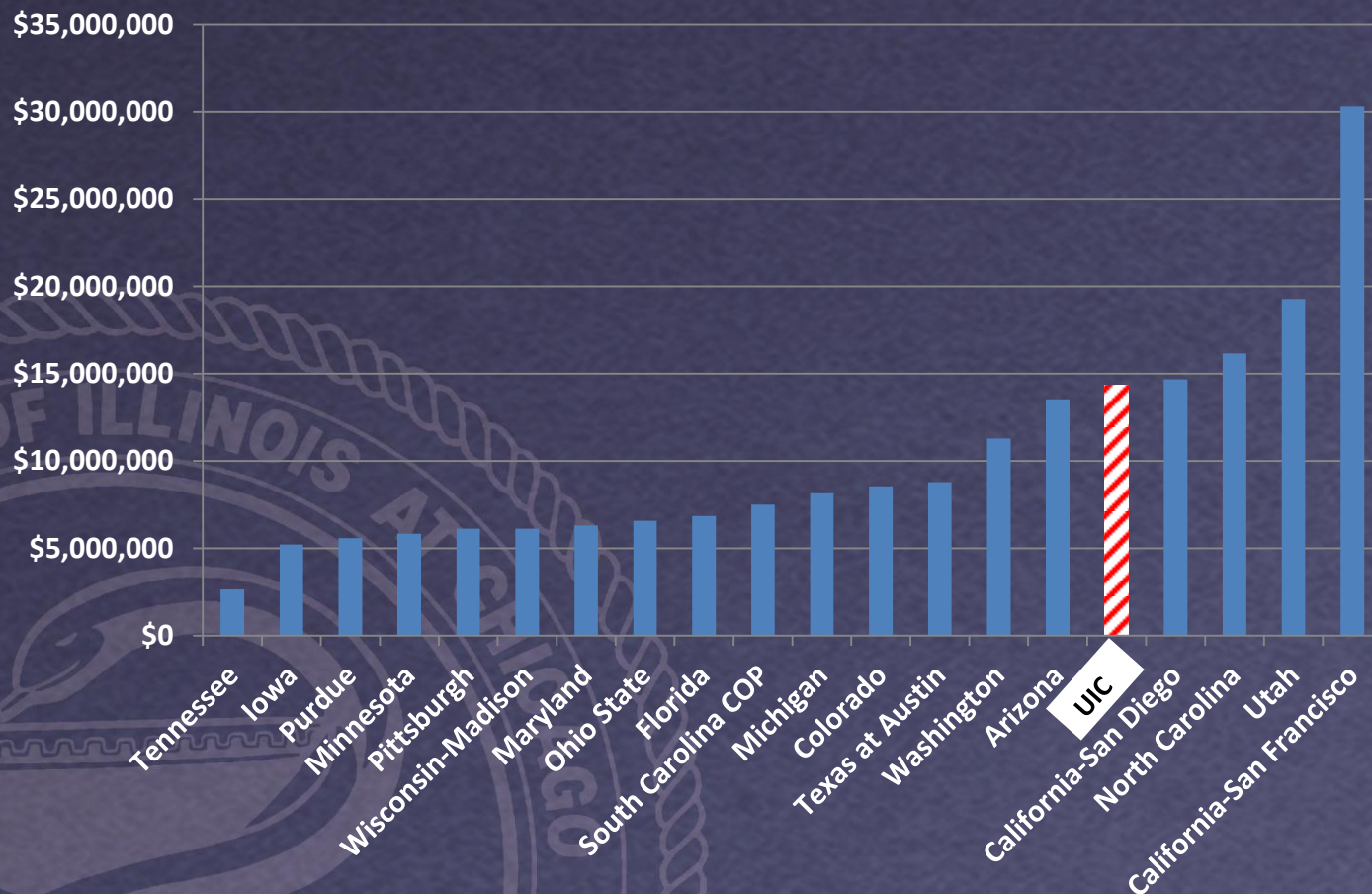
MS and PhD Enrollment per Year



Grant Awards per Year

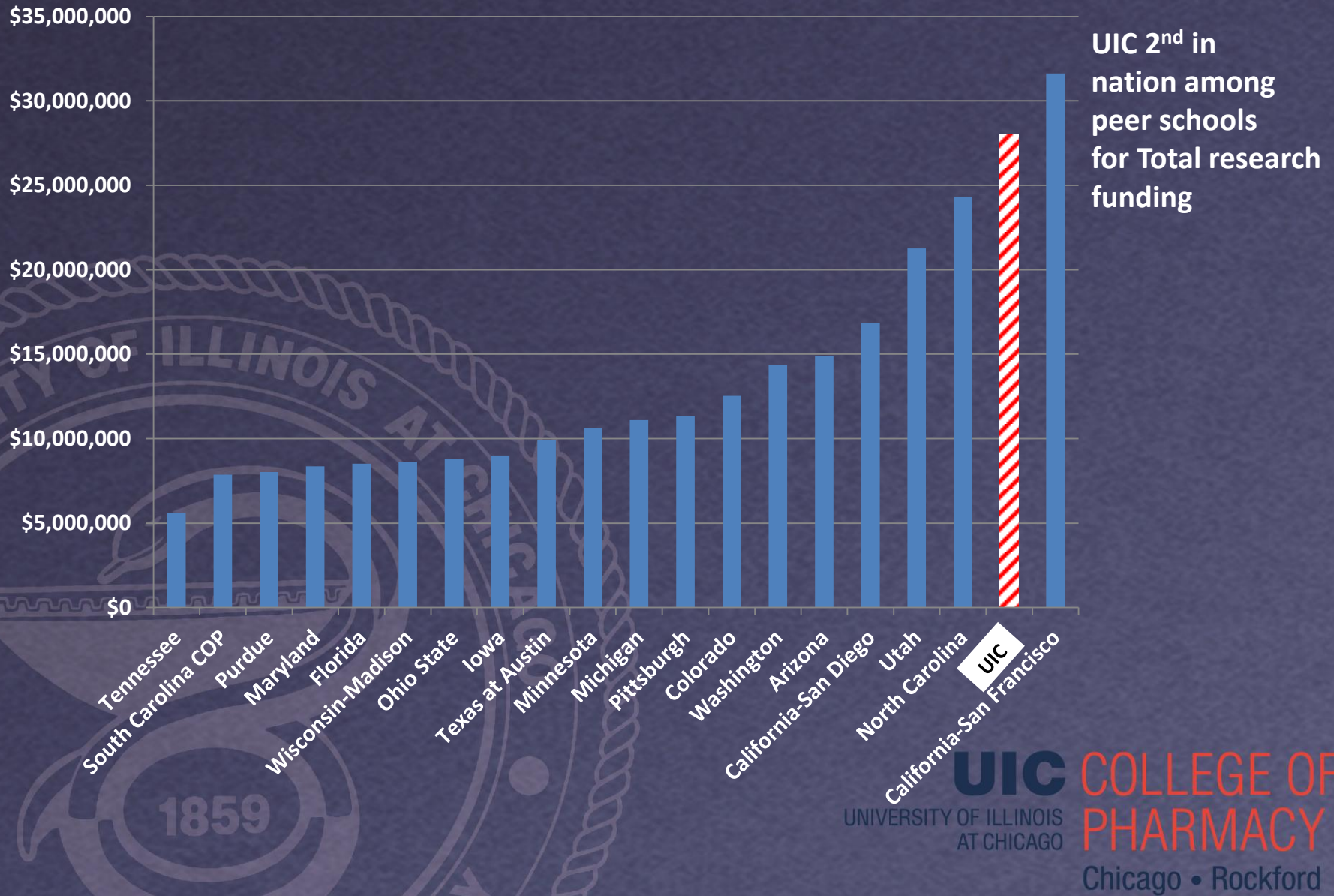


Ranking by NIH Funding Received, 2009-2010

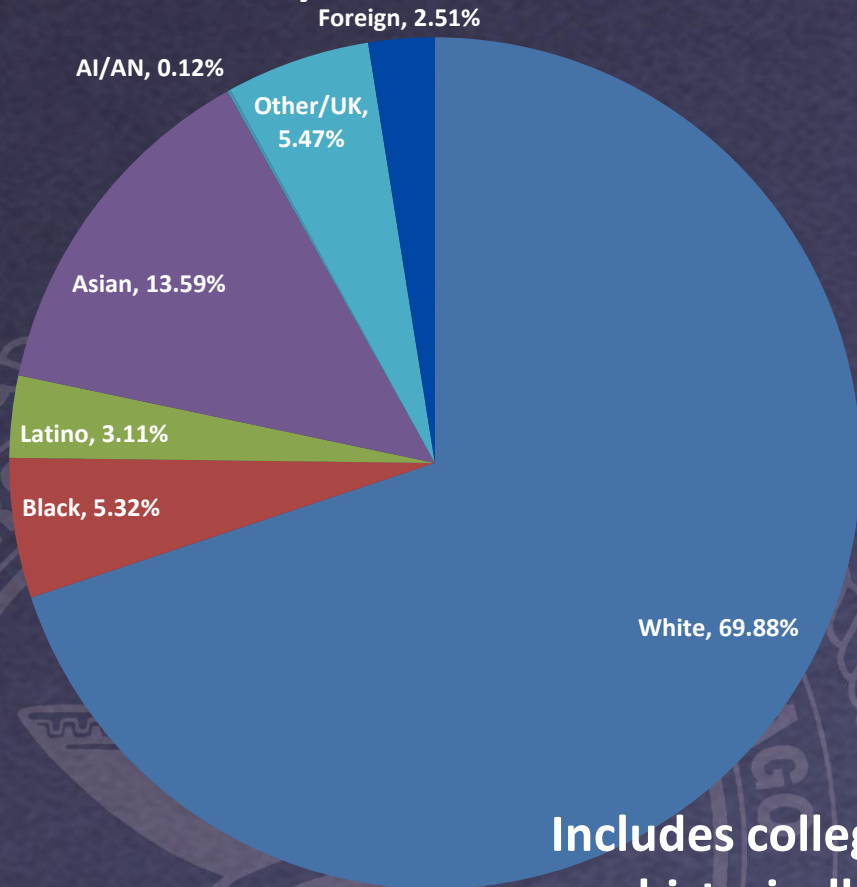

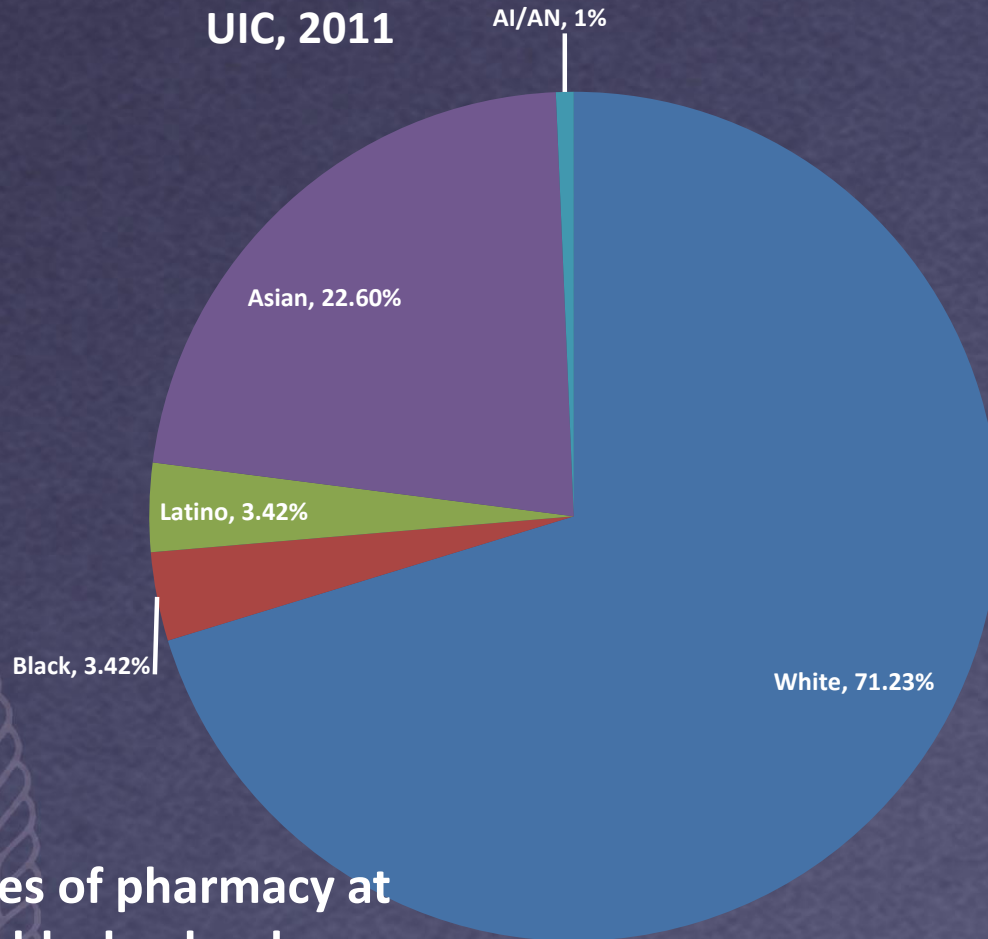

All US Pharmacy Schools, 2010

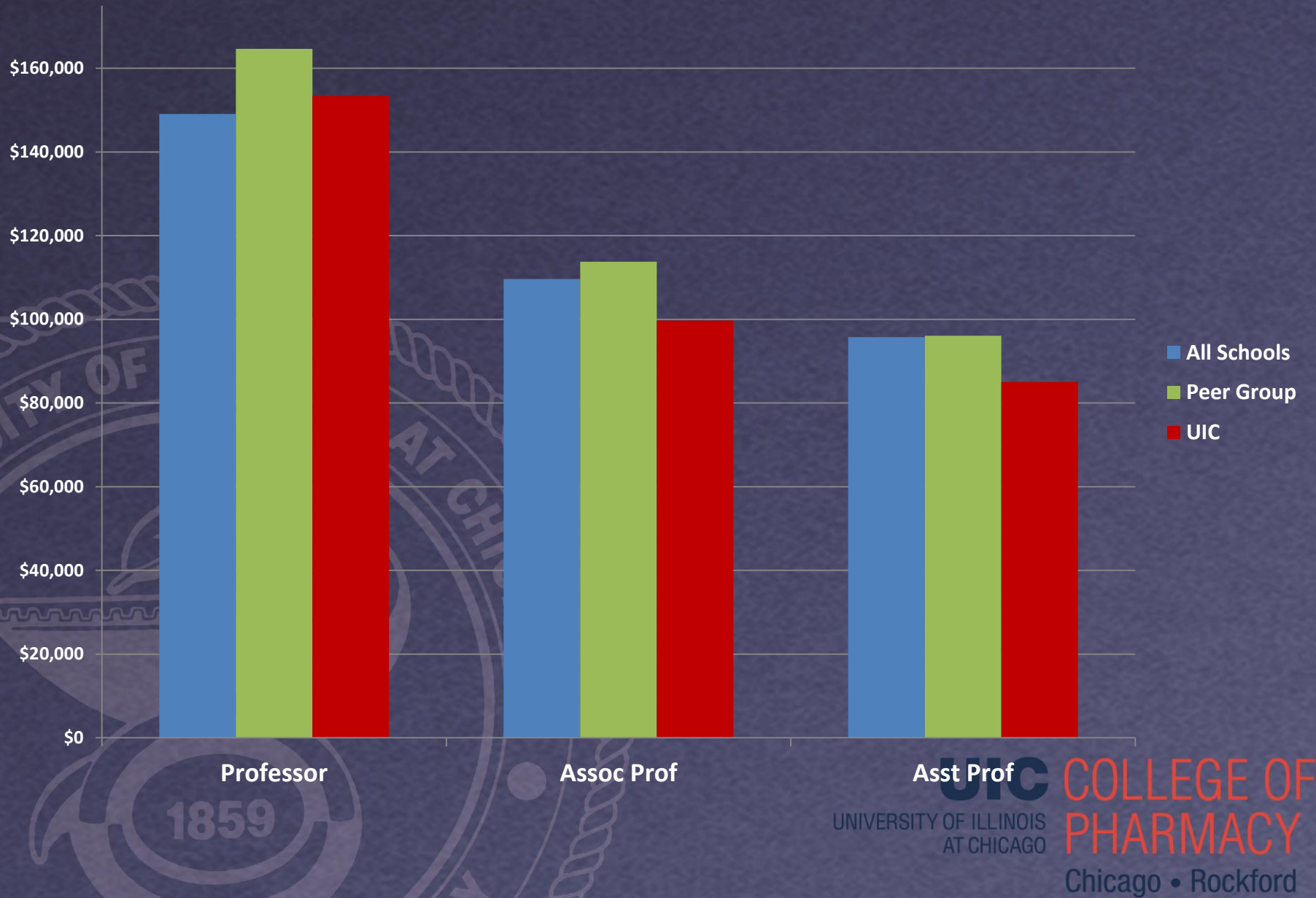

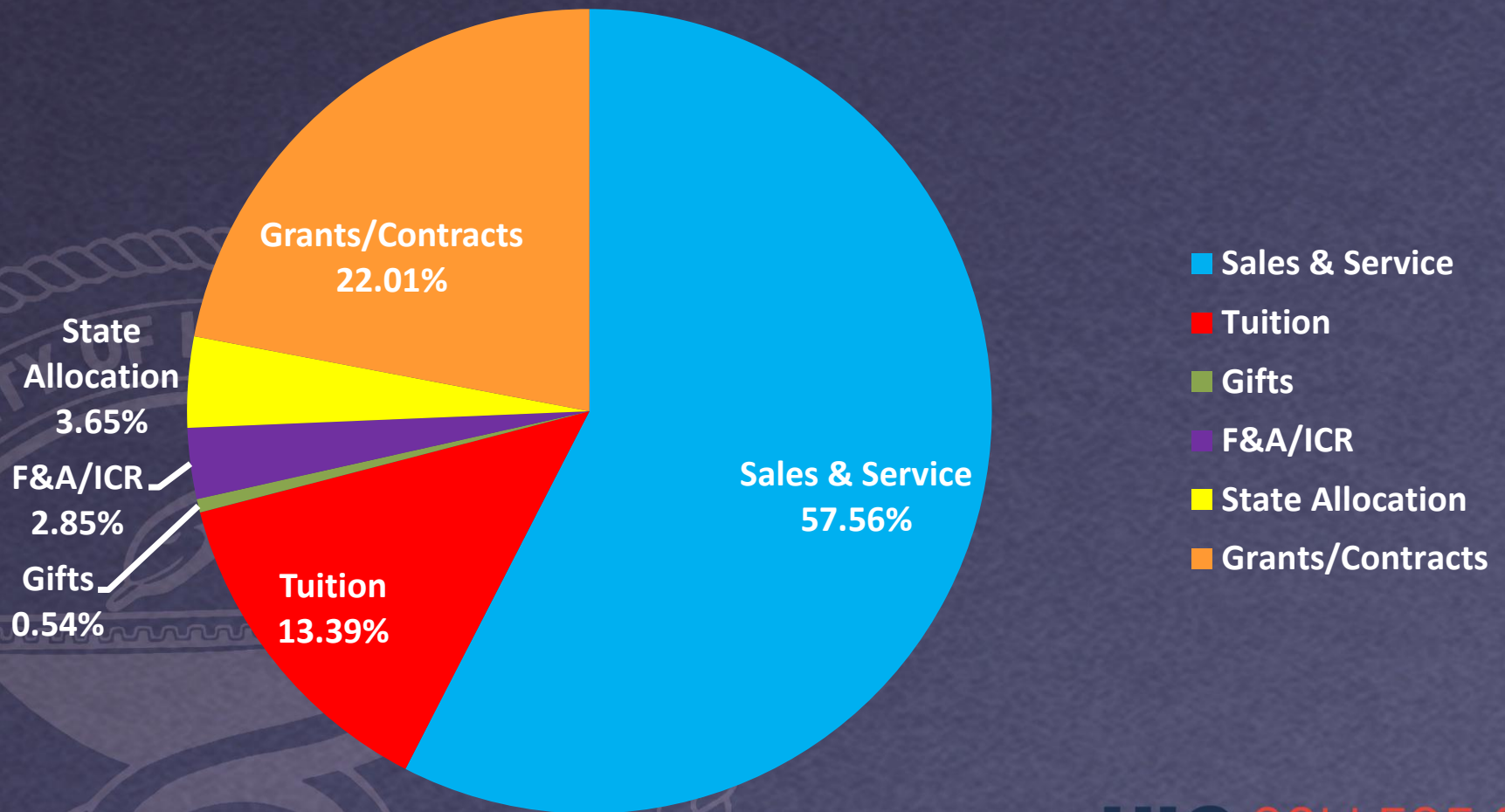
