APPOINT INTERIM DEAN, COLLEGE OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS AND ADMINISTRATION, SPRINGFIELD

Action: Appoint Interim Dean, College of Public Affairs and Administration

Funding: State Appropriated Funds

The Chancellor, University of Illinois at Springfield, and Vice President, University of Illinois has recommended the appointment of James Ermatinger, currently Professor of History and Dean, College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and, as Interim Dean, College of Public Affairs and Administration, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, with an administrative increment of \$24,000, beginning November 16, 2015.

In addition, Dr. Ermatinger will continue to serve as Dean, College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, on 100 percent time, at an annual salary of \$160,925, effective November 16, 2015; and Professor of History, College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, on indefinite tenure, on an academic year service basis, non-salaried, effective August 16, 2015, for a total salary of \$184,925.

Dr. Ermatinger served as Interim Dean Designate, College of Public Affairs and Administration, non-tenured, on a twelve-month service basis, with an administrative increment of \$12,000, October 13, 2015 through November 15, 2015. Dr. Ermatinger

succeeds Acting Dean David Racine, who resigned as Acting Dean, College of Public Affairs and Administration, effective October 12, 2015.
