AWARD CONTRACT FOR EXTERIOR RENOVATIONS, KRANNERT CENTER FOR PERFORMING ARTS, URBANA

- Action: Approve the Award of a Contract for Exterior Renovations, Krannert Center for Performing Arts
- **Funding**: Academic Facilities Maintenance Fund Assessment Fund and Institutional Fund Operating Budget

This project will address deficiencies associated with the exterior of the Playhouse Theater and Studio Theater at the Krannert Center for Performing Arts, including concrete masonry unit back-up and face brick reconstruction and cavity wall insulation. Overall, this project will have an impact on the integrity and appearance of these theaters while increasing energy efficiency. Minor interior finish work will address some areas of water damage.

Bids for the construction work have been solicited, and for the project to proceed, the Chancellor, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and the Vice President, University of Illinois with the concurrence of the appropriate administrative officers recommends that the following contract be awarded. Competitive bidding procedures in accordance with the Illinois Procurement Code were followed; and the award is to the lowest responsible bidder on the basis of its base bid plus the acceptance of indicated alternate¹:
