Dollars in millions

- Average Daily Census for FY13 was 4.5% below budget, Outpatient utilization is 1.8% below
- Medicaid revenue reflects recent receipt of revised rate letter from HFS for FY13
- FY 13 Charity Care projected at \$46.2M versus FY12 of \$42.0M

- Total Operating Expenses for FY 13 were 0.7% below budget or \$5.6M+ under budget due to management efforts
- FTEs for FY 13 were 87.0 below budget and 5.0 less than in FY 12

- Expense reductions and revenue cycle improvements along with a projected rate modification by Medicaid yield a better than expected year end performance
- Investment gains were \$1.5M better than expected for FY 13

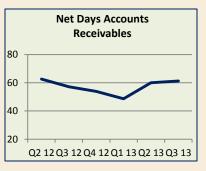
