

MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SEPTEMBER 11, 1914.

A meeting of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois was held at Hotel LaSalle, in Chicago, on Friday, September 11, 1914, immediately following the adjournment of the meeting of the board held on that date.

There were present Mr. Abbott and Mr. Moore, members of the Executive Committee; Mr. Blair, Mrs. Evans, Mrs. Henrotin, and Mr. Hoyt, members of the board, and President James.

PRINTING OF ANNUAL REPORTS.

President James presented and asked for authority to print the report of the Comptroller for the past year. He stated also that the President is preparing a report to the board which, with the Comptroller's and Registrar's reports, will cover the entire administration of the University.

On motion of Mr. Moore, President James was authorized to have these reports printed.

CHANGES IN AGRICULTURAL SALARY BUDGET.

President James presented a recommendation from the Dean of the College of Agriculture and Director of the Experiment Station for certain changes in the budget of the College of Agriculture and the Experiment Station as printed on pages 28 to 34.

(1) That the title of Mr. J. J. Gardner be changed from Instructor in Pomology in the College and Assistant in Pomology in the Station to Associate in Pomology in the College of Agriculture and the Agricultural Experiment Station, the error being due to an oversight in the office of the Dean.

(2) That the title of Mr. Fred W. Muncie be changed from First Assistant in Floriculture, Station, to First Assistant in Floricultural Chemistry in the Agricultural Experiment Station, a title which accurately expresses his work.

(3) That the title of Mr. I. D. Allison be Associate in Horticulture, College and Station, instead of Assistant in Horticulture, Station.

(4) That the salary of Mr. G. L. Peltier be advanced from \$1,200 to \$1,600 per year. The original recommendation was due to an oversight in not remembering that Mr. Peltier now goes on full time instead of half time as heretofore.

(5) That Miss Florence E. Smith be appointed Secretary to the Director of the Agricultural Experiment Station and Miss Hawgood, Secretary to the Dean of the College of Agriculture.

(6) That Mr. Elmer Roberts be appointed Instructor in Genetics in the College of Agriculture and First Assistant in Genetics in the Agricultural Experiment Station.

On motion of Mr. Moore, the changes were approved as recommended.

SALARY BUDGET, SUPERVISING ARCHITECT'S OFFICE.

President James presented a recommendation from Prof. J. M. White, Supervising Architect, that the following increases in the salaries of members of his office staff be made:
