The November meeting of the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois was held at the University, in Urbana, at 10 o'clock a. m., on Saturday, November 3, 1923.

MATTERS PRESENTED BY PRESIDENT KINLEY

The Board considered the following matters presented by the President of the University.

GIFT FROM SENATOR WILLIAM B. MCKINLEY

(1) Senator William B. McKinley, of Champaign, authorizes me to say that he will donate to the University one thousand shares of certain stock, yielding at present an annual income of \$7,000, for the endowment of a chair in the economics of transportation, in the field of administration. If the Board of Trustees accepts this gift, it will be asked to agree that the present annual income of this stock, namely \$7,000, shall be maintained by the Board of Trustees as the salary of the chair thus endowed.

On motion of Mrs. Blake, the President of the University was authorized to accept this gift under the conditions outlined.

On motion of Mrs. Evans, the President of the University was requested to express to Senator McKinley the thanks of the Board.

NEW ASSISTANT FOR THE COLLEGE OF LAW

CONSULTING ENTOMOLOGIST OF THE AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION

Flint, Chief Entomologist of the Natural History Survey, be appointed Consulting Entomologist of the Agricultural Experiment Station, without salary, to be effective at once, to succeed Professor-Emeritus S. A. Forbes who was appointed Consulting Entomologist December 9, 1890.
