UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS

June 15, 1934



The June meeting of the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois was held at the Blackstone Hotel, in Chicago, at 10 o'clock a.m., on Friday, June 15, 1934.

MATTERS PRESENTED BY PRESIDENT DANIELS

The Board considered the following matters presented by the Acting President of the University.

REAPPROPRIATION OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES

(1) A recommendation that the following balances which it is estimated will lapse on June 30, 1934, be reappropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1934:

SUBSIDY FOR SYMPHONY CONCERTS

(2) A request from the University Concert and Entertainment Board for a subsidy of \$1,000 for 1934-35 to enable it to offer two symphony orchestra concerts in place of one. Funds are available in the appropriation for Public Functions for this purpose if needed. If the concerts should be well enough patronized to make this subsidy unnecessary, the subsidy would not be used.

On motion of Mr. Trees, this subsidy was authorized.

RESIDENCE HALL FUNDS

(3) A recommendation from the Comptroller that hereafter any surplus from the operation of the women's residence halls, over and above current operation and maintenance expenses and a suitable reserve for maintenance and replacement, be carried to the general income account of the University.

On motion of Dr. Meyer, this recommendation was approved.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR PROFESSOR OTTO F. KAMPMEIER

(4) A request from Professor Otto F. Kampmeier, Head of the Department of Anatomy in the College of Medicine, for a sabbatical leave of absence for one-half year on one-half pay during the second semester of 1934-35, under the statutes of the University. The Dean of the College of Medicine recommends approval and I concur. I recommend that this leave be for six months beginning March 1, 1935.

On motion of Mr. Armstrong, this leave was granted.

**EXTENSION OF LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR PROFESSOR
M. J. WASSERMAN**

(5) A request from Assistant Professor M. J. Wasserman, of the Department of Economics, who was given leave of absence without pay for six months from February 1, 1934, so that he might render service to the Agricultural Administration in Washington, for an extension of his leave, without pay, for one year from September 1, 1934. The Dean of the College and Head of the Department recommend approval. I concur.

On motion of Mr. Barr, this extension was granted.

ADMISSION TO THE COLLEGE OF MEDICINE

(6) The proposed changes in the requirements for admission to the College of Medicine.

On motion of Mr. Trees, this matter was referred to the Committee on Chicago Departments for further consideration and report.

At this point, Mr. Barr withdrew.

CHANGES IN SCHOLARSHIPS

(7) Certain data and recommendations have been submitted by a faculty committee on scholarships to the Board Committee on Scholarships. The changes recommended would involve amendment of the laws in certain respects, and it is therefore desirable that some decision be reached by the Board soon. If these recommendations are adopted the matter should be brought to the attention of the Governor with a view to having the laws amended accordingly.

The special committee on tuition fees and scholarships was requested to report on this matter at the July meeting of the Board.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR PROFESSOR R. C. ASHBY

(8) A report that Associate Professor R. C. Ashby, of the Department of Agricultural Economics, has been given a month's leave of absence with pay, in addition to his vacation allowance of one month, on account of his health.

This report was received for record.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR E. A. NORTON

(9) A recommendation that E. A. Norton, Assistant Chief in Soil Survey, be given an indeterminate leave of absence, but not to exceed one year, beginning June 10, 1934, without pay, in order that he may accept a temporary appointment as Project Director of Southern Illinois for the Land Policy Section of the Submarginal Land Committee of the Federal Surplus Relief Corporation.

On motion of Mr. Trees, this leave was granted.

DEATH BENEFIT—DR. CARL A. HEDBLUM

(10) A report of the death on June 6, 1934, of Dr. Carl A. Hedblom, Professor and Head of the Department of Surgery. The death benefit payable in this case, in accordance with the statutes of the University and with the terms of his contract, is \$2,808. The Comptroller has been authorized to make this payment to Doctor Hedblom's designated beneficiary.

**APPOINTMENT OF DR. ERIC OLDBERG AS ACTING HEAD
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SURGERY**

(11) A report that because of the sudden death of Dr. Carl A. Hedblom, Professor and Head of the Department of Surgery, Dr. Eric Oldberg, Assistant Professor in that Department, has been appointed Acting Head until further notice.

On motion of Dr. Meyer, this action was approved.

APPOINTMENT OF DR. FRANCIS L. LEDERER AS HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LARYNGOLOGY, RHINOLOGY, AND OTOTOLOGY

(12) A recommendation that Dr. Francis L. Lederer, who has served as Acting Head of the Department of Laryngology, Rhinology, and Otology for the past two years, be appointed Head of the Department on indefinite tenure, effective immediately, at his present salary rate of \$1,630 for half-time service.

On motion of Dr. Meyer, this appointment was made.

RETIREMENT OF DR. HAIM I. DAVIS

(13) A recommendation that Dr. Haim I. Davis, Professor of Psychiatry on the clinical faculty in the College of Medicine, be retired under the statutes of the University effective September 1, 1934, with the title of Professor of Psychiatry, *Emeritus*.

This recommendation was adopted.

ADVANCE DEPOSIT OF FEES IN UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL

(20) A recommendation from the Principal of the University High School, the Dean of the College of Education, and the Comptroller that the following regulation be adopted:

"Students who wish to enter either the sub-freshman or special group freshman classes of the University High School will be examined by the Principal and those who are successful will be pre-registered by the Principal in the spring. Such students will be required to pay a deposit fee of \$5.00 on or before a date in June to be fixed each year by the Comptroller and the Principal. This deposit will be refunded if the Principal is notified, on or before a date in August to be fixed each year by the Comptroller and the Principal, that the student cannot attend. Otherwise, it shall be applied as part payment of his fees for the first semester. In case he does not enter at that time, the deposit will be forfeited."

I concur in this recommendation. As it was necessary to put the plan into operation at once, if it is to be used this year, I authorized the Business Office to go ahead with the arrangements for this year.

PURCHASES OF LUMBER AND COPPER AUTHORIZED

1 car mixed lumber, including white pine, fir, and cypress, from T. A. Foley Lumber Company, Paris, Illinois, at a cost of \$2,969.75 F.O.B. Urbana. This is the lowest of competitive quotations received from various companies.

Soft copper, 400 pieces—30" x 96", 16 ounce—at a cost of approximately \$1400. This is to replace the copper now on the west radius band of the Armory roof.

On motion of Mr. Trees, these purchases were authorized.

REPORT OF PURCHASES

(23) The following report of purchases authorized by the President of the University since the last report:

1. One 12 x 18 Kluge Automatic Unit printing press complete with motor equipment from Brandtjen and Kluge, Inc., Chicago, at a net cost of \$1,780 F.O.B. Urbana. This includes an allowance for an old press. The equipment is for the use of the Print Shop and will be paid for from the surplus in the Print Shop revolving fund. This equipment is needed to replace an old press which is inefficient and unreasonably expensive to operate. In view of an impending rise in the price, an emergency existed and the immediate purchase of this equipment was authorized.

2. Two carloads of roofing slate—

(a) 77 squares black slate from L. F. Owens Company, Quarries, Chicago, at a price of \$980.49 F.O.B. Urbana.

(b) 60 squares of colored slate from the F. C. Sheldon Slate Company, Granville, New York, at a price of \$834.24 F.O.B. Urbana.

3. Trimming and doctoring of trees on the campus, under the direction of the Superintendent of Grounds, at a cost of 85¢ per man per hour, plus material at cost, by Hubert Hunsucker, landscape architect, of Champaign. The cost of this work will

be in excess of \$1,000. Funds are available in the Physical Plant budget for the current year to cover the cost. None of this work was done last year.

4. One carload of roll felt, coal tar, concrete primer, and roof putty for the Physical Plant stock and particularly for use on the new steam line to the McKinley Hospital, from Roofing and Insulation Company of Champaign (Johns-Manville distributors), at a cost of \$1,602.79 F.O.B. Urbana. As the materials will be needed in the work on the steam line for the week beginning June 18, an emergency existed and the purchase was therefore authorized.

PURCHASE OF PAPER FOR AGRICULTURAL PUBLICATIONS
